Come now Gertrude Rashata, petitioner and widow of Eli G. Rashata, also known as Elie G. Rashata, deceased, and files her verified Petition for Widow's Allowance and For Order of No Administration, which petition is in the words and figures following, to-wit: (Here Insert).

And the Court, having examined said petition, and being fully advised, finds that the facts stated in said petition are true; that the funeral charges of said decedent and the expenses of this proceeding have been paid; that a widow's allowance should be made to petitioner in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00); that the value of the gross estate of decedent less liens and encumbrances thereon, not including the homestead interest, is Thirteen Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$1,380.00); that said widow's allowance will exhaust the entire assets of the estate and said assets should be transferred and set aside to the petitioner who, as widow of said decedent, is entitled to have the same vested in her, and that no administration is necessary.

hereby confirmed in her as her sole and separate property.


3. That no administration be had on said decedent's estate
