1969, This cause came on to be heard this 28 day of March, upon the Executor's Final Account and Petition (1) To Settle and Allow Account and (2) For Authority To Distribute Estate, filed by the Mercantile National Bank of Hammond, as Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Lee Sexton, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit: (N.I.) And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises, Now Finds:

1. That Waiver of Service by Mail of Notice and Consent to Final Accounting by all legatees herein having been filed and due notice of filing of said account and petition was given and same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
2. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Executor has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into its hands.
3. The amounts claimed as credits for Executor's and attorney's fees are just and reasonable for services rendered to date and for normal anticipated services to be rendered in connection with the final distribution.
4. More than six months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims against said estate have been paid and discharged;

taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, It Is Ordered and Decreed by the Court as follows:

1. Said report and account of said Executor is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
2. Said Executor is hereby directed to distribute the balance of assets in hand for distribution as follows:
  - (a) Six (6) rooms of household goods of the value of \$235.00 to Charles G. Sexton and Nancy J. Sexton equally.
3. Pursuant to decedent's Will the real estate of which she died seized and which was undisposed of by sale or otherwise during the period of administration is hereby vested in the following named persons:

Parcel No. 1 Charles G. Sexton - Lot 100 and the East half of Lot 101, Hammond Realty Company's Second Addition to the City of Hammond, also known as 1019 Becker Street, Hammond, Indiana.

Parcel No. 2 Nancy J. Sexton - Lots 31 and 32, Block 8, Oak Forest Addition to Griffith, also known as 315 North Broad Street, Griffith, Indiana.

Said Executor is hereby directed to procure and to record in the office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, a certified copy of this final decree.

4. Said Executor is hereby directed to file herein its Supplemental Report of Distribution and attach thereto its receipts and vouchers showing the distribution of the balance of assets pursuant to the terms of this order and that said Executor has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree.

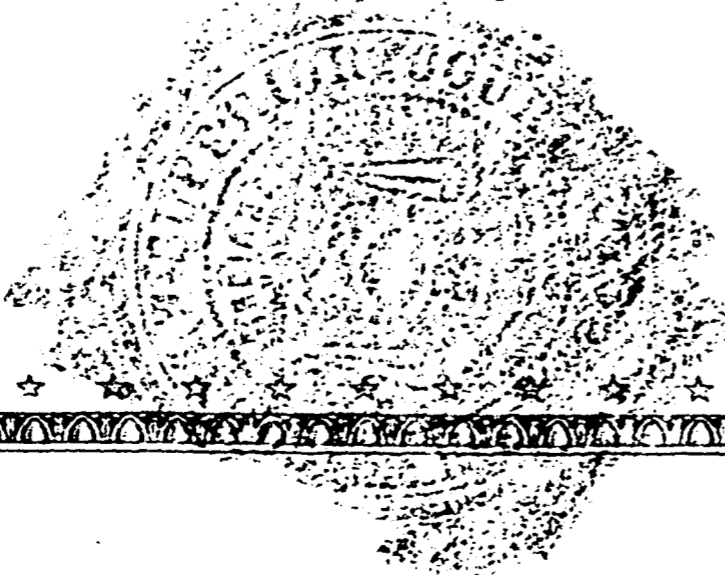
