ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF S 22 DE 13

The undersigned incorporator or incorporators, desiring to form a corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation") pursuant to the provisions of The Indiana General Corporation Act, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"), execute the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the Corporation is E & F TRANSPORT, INC.

ARTICLE II

Purposes

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed are:

- (1) To engage in the business of transporting general commodities and property of every kind and nature for hire by motor vehicle and other means of conveyance, as a common carrier or otherwise, and to acquire, own, lease, operate, and dispose of like equipment and businesses.
- (2) To do all acts and things necessary, convenient or expedient to carry out the purpose for which it is formed; and, in general to carry on any and all other business and to have and exercise any and all other powers allowed under the Act to corporations formed for the above and foregoing purposes.



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ARTICLE III

Term of Existence

The period during which the Corporation shall continue is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

Number of Shares

The total number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 1000 shares with the par value of per share, and 1000 shares without par value.

ARTICLE VI

Terms of Shares

The said shares of authorized capital stock shall consist of one thousand (1,000) shares of one class of common capital stock, without par value. Every share of the no par value common stock whenever and for whatever consideration issued shall be equal to every other share of such common stock and shall be entitled to the same rights as every other share of such common stock and all distributions of earnings or assets of the Corporation shall be distributable to the holders of such common stock.

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ARTICLE VII

Voting Rights of Shares

Each share of the common stock shall be entitled to one (1) vote at every shareholders meeting on all questions submitted to shareholders.

ARTICLE VIII Initial Stated Capital

The Corporation will not commence business until consideration of the value of at least \$ 1,000,00 has been received for the issuance of shares.

ARTICLE D

Directors

Section 1. Number. The initial board of directors shall be composed of three members. The number of directors may from time to time be fixed by the by-laws of the Corporation at any number, not less than three. In the absence of a by-law fixing the number of directors, the number shall be three

Section 2. Qualifications. Directors need not he shareholders of the Corporation.

Provisions for Regulation of Business and Conduct of Affairs of Corporation

Said by-laws may be amended or repealed in part or additions made thereto at any meeting of the Board of Directors by a vote of the majority of the Board of Directors.
