Remide M. Austin, being first duly sworn upon her oath, deposes and says, to-wit:

That she now resides at 1003 East 6th Street, Hobart, Lake County, Indiana and is the abrivious widow of James E. Austin a/k/a James Edward Austin deceased, who died on the 26th day of July, 1969, and whose record of death is duly entered in the records maintained by the Lake County Health Department, Indiana State Board of Health, Division of Vital Records, Local Record \$366-69. Further that the said James E. Austin, deceased, died in the residence of this affiant and the said decedent at the above address.

That this affiant and her now deceased husband, James E.

time they acquired title as tenants by the entireties to the

Austin, deceased, died testate, that the Last Will and Testament of said decedent was admitted to probate in cause # CE69-134, Lake Circuit Court, Crown Point, Indiana, that no administration of his estate has been commenced, that none is now pending and that none is contemplated; that the gross value of the estate of the said James E. Austin, deceased, taking into consideration in the valuation thereof the value of all of his gifts made by him in the three years next preceding his death, and the value of all of his investments and joint properties and estates by the entireties, including the real estate above described, plus the proceeds of the life insurance on his life, did not equal or exceed the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), as a consequence of which his estate was not subject to U.S. Estate Tax.
