taxes.

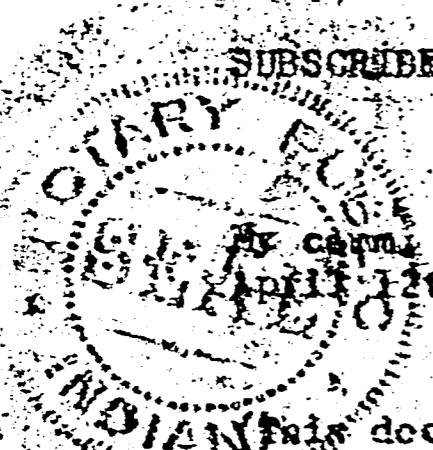
3. That the said FRANK DWOZNIK and PEARL DWOZNIK remained
