that he attaches hereto a certified copy of her death certificate.

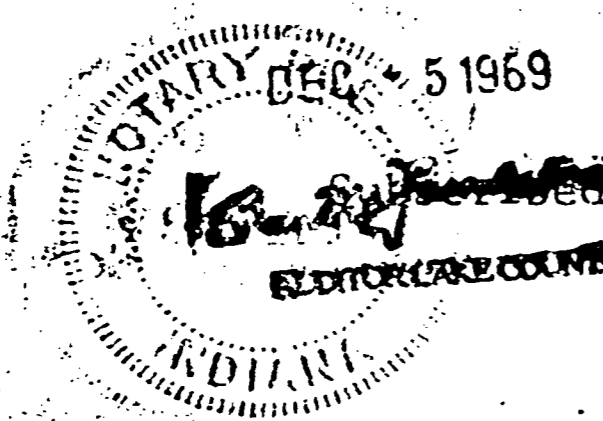
That affiant and his said wife, Gladys Searl, lived together
