THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That COMBUSTION ENGINEERING, INC., a Delaware Corporation of Lake County, in the State of Delaware, CONVEY and WARRANT to MASTER JOBBERS, INC., an Indiana Corporation, - mailing address P. O. Box 867, East Chicago, Indiana, 46312 in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, for and in consideration of Ten (\$10.00) and other valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the following described real estate in Lake County, in the State of Indiana, to-wit:

PARCEL I; That part of Lot 1 of the Original United States Government Survey of Section 32, Township 37 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian, described as beginning at a point on the South line of the 100 foot right of way conveyed to the Western Indiana Railway Company by deed dated July 25, 1896 and recorded in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana, in Deed Record 79 pages 312 to 313, now controlled by the Elgin, Joliet & Eastern Railway Company, said point being 76 feet East of the West line of Lot 1 aforesaid; thence South on a line parallel to and 76 feet East of the West line of Lot 1 aforesaid 1477.3 feet, more or less, to the Grand Calumet River; thence Northeasterly along the Grand Calumet River to the West line of the 200 foot right of way conveyed to the United States of America by deed dated July 5, 1888 and recorded in the Recorder's Office aforesaid in Deed Record 4 pages 478 and 479, said right of way line being parallel to and 100 feet West of the East line of said Section 32; thence North on last described line 270.8 feet, more or less, to the South line of the 100 foot right of way of the Western Indiana Railway Company aforesaid; thence West along said right of way line 1140.62 feet to the point of beginning, in Lake County, Indiana, and easements for ingress and egress over and on the following described Parcels numbered II and III;


