That Mary Zavesky and Charles Zavesky were married at the time they acquired title to the above described property and continued to be married up until the time of the death of the above mentioned Nary Zavesky.

That the above mentioned Mary Zavesky did not leave assets of a sufficient amount to require the filing of a Federal Estate Tax Return and that, when the above mentioned Mary Zavesky died, there were no federal estate taxes chargeable to her property.
