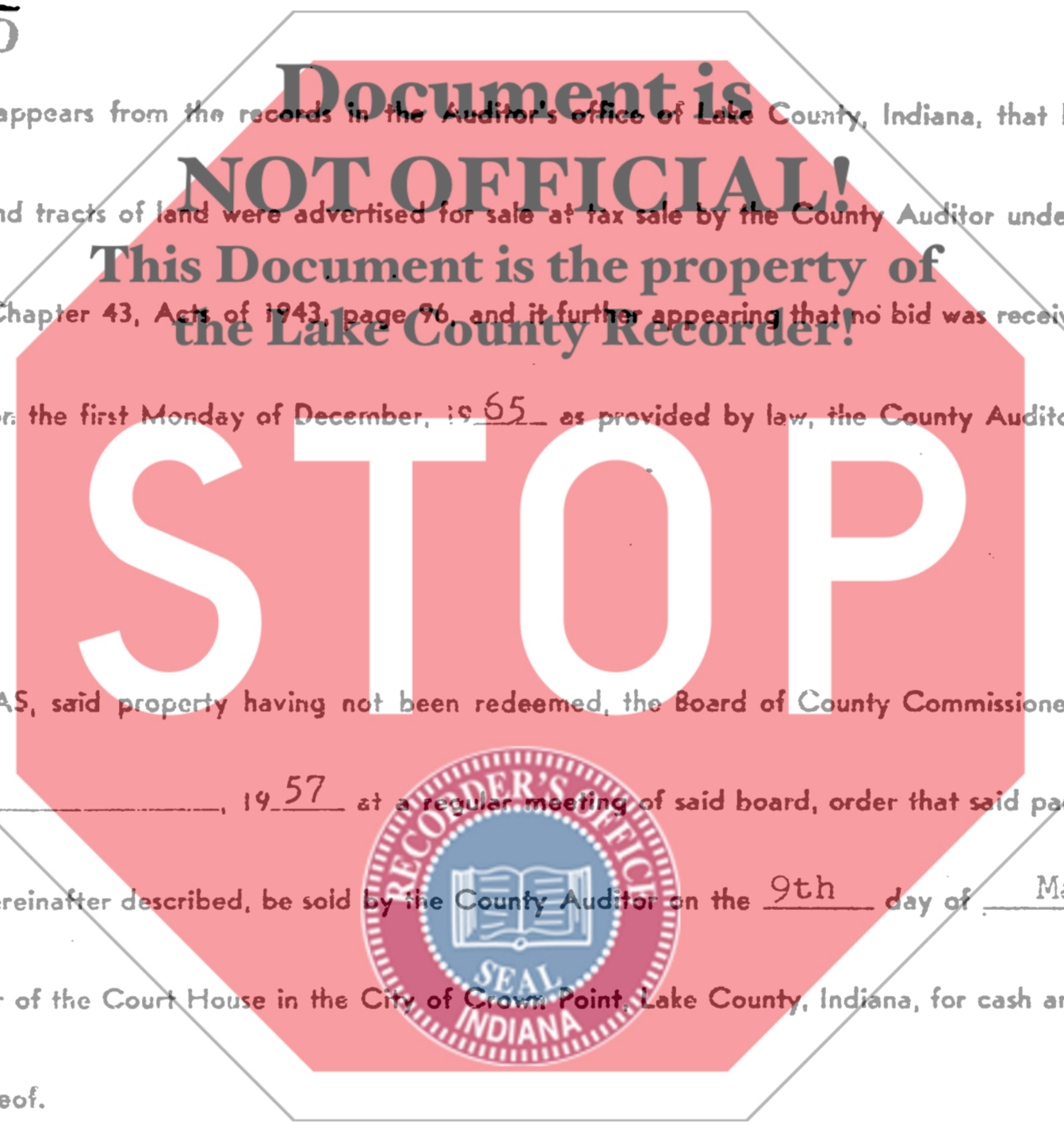


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WHEREAS, it appears from the records in the Auditor's office of Lake County, Indiana, that heretofore various and divers pieces, lots and tracts of land were advertised for sale at tax sale by the County Auditor under the terms and provisions of Section 1, Chapter 43, Acts of 1943, page 96, and it further appearing that no bid was received for the sale of such property, and that on the first Monday of December, 1965, as provided by law, the County Auditor bid in such property for Lake County.



AND, WHEREAS, said property having not been redeemed, the Board of County Commissioners did on the 1st day of July, 1957, at a regular meeting of said board, order that said parcels, lots and tracts of said real estate as hereinafter described, be sold by the County Auditor on the 9th day of March, 1970, at the door of the Court House in the City of Crown Point, Lake County, Indiana, for cash and for not less than the appraised value thereof.

AND, WHEREAS, it appears that notice of the time, terms and place of sale of said real estate was published and posted as required by law,

AND, WHEREAS, it appears that on the day named in the order of the Board of Commissioners, and in the notice as published and posted, the said County Auditor did offer said real estate for sale.

AND, WHEREAS, Howard A. Meyer did then and there bid the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen dollars and no cents, and that the County Auditor did then and there accept said bid.

AND, WHEREAS, it appears that Howard A Meyer did thereupon pay the amount of his bid to the County Treasurer of said county in cash.

AND, WHEREAS, the County Auditor did on the 16th day of March, 1970 report his proceedings therein to the Board of Commissioners.

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NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Lake County, State of Indiana, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen dollars and no cents paid as aforesaid, does hereby convey to Howard A. Meyer all the right, title and interest, without warranty other than as provided by law, in and to the following described real estate in Lake County, Indiana, to-wit:

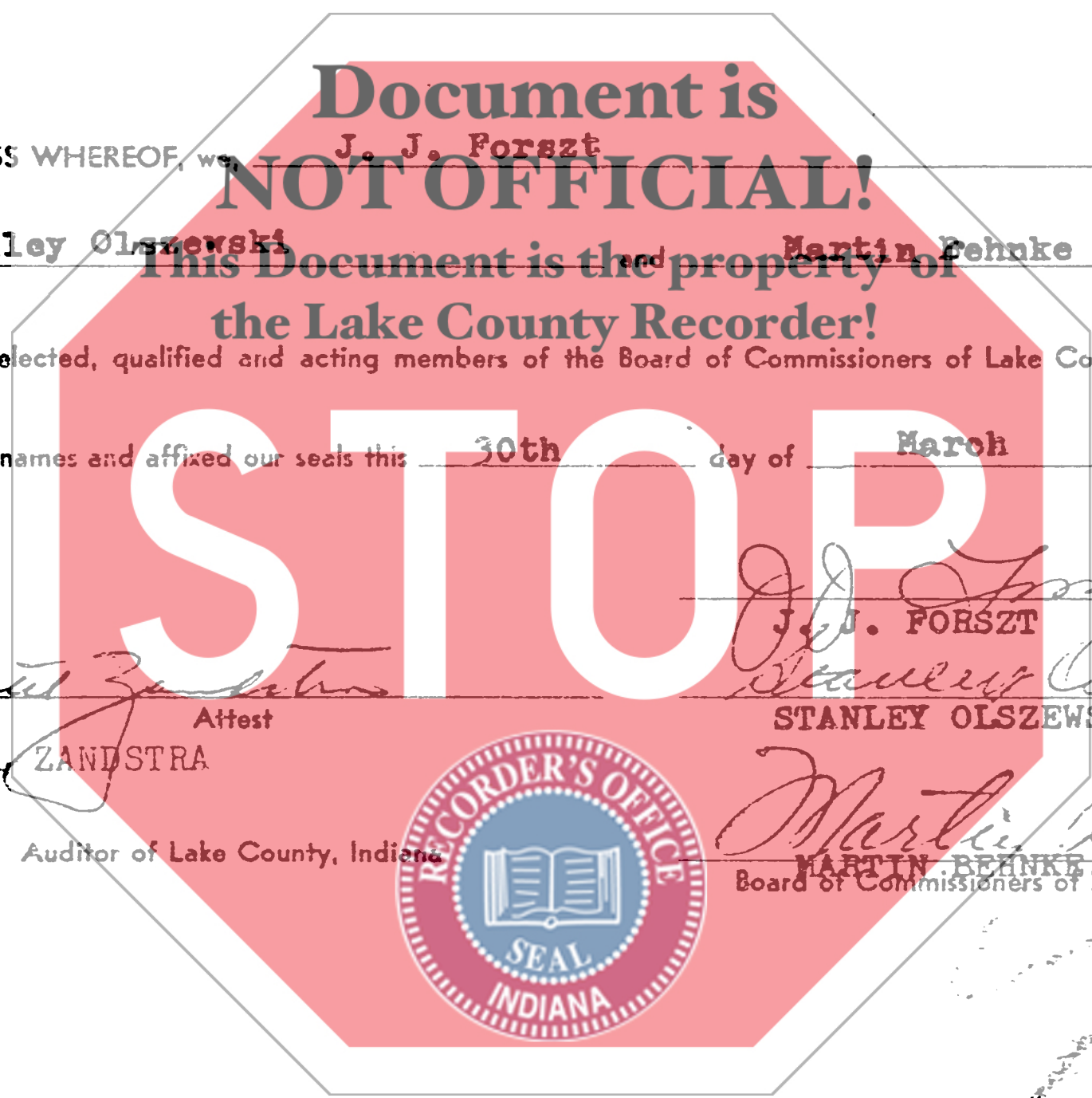
