THIS CAUSE came on to be heard this ^{1st} day of May, 1970, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account, and petition for authority to distribute estate, and the supplemental report filed and presented by Harold J. Helbling, as Co-Administrator with Will annexed of the Last Will and Testament and estate of Helen A. Moll, deceased, which account and petition are in the following words and figures, to-wit: (H.I.) and it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises NOW FINDS:

1. That due notice of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to the heir of said decedent and all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. The matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Administrator has accounted for all of the assets of this estate coming into his hands.

3. More than six months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors herein; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her Administrator were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; that no inheritance taxes are owed, by lapse of time, nor income taxes unpaid against said estate; and said estate was not subject to federal estate taxes.
