That they are the widow, children and grandchildren and the widow of a child of GEORGE H. STONE who died a resident of Illinois on February 4, 1961 the owner of Lots numbered 184 to 191 both inclusive as marked and laid down on the recorded plat of Pon & Company's Wildwood Shores as shown in Plat Book 26 page 38 in Lake County, Indiana; that said George H. Stone left no Will and had no other property in the State of Indiana and his estate everywhere was of a value under \$60,000.00. These Affiants further state that said George H. Stone left surviving him his widow, Florence Stone with whom he was living at the time of his death, who was his second and childless wife; that his first wife was Elizabeth Stone who died July 18, 1948; that to the first marriage of said George H. 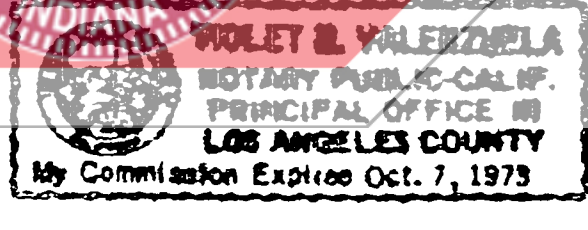

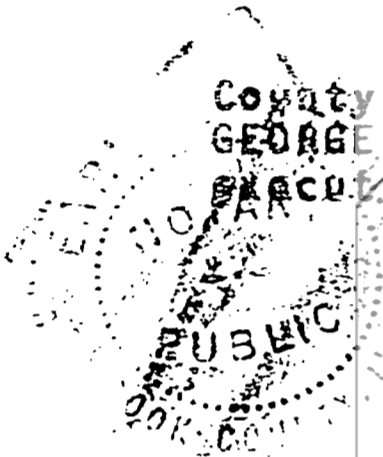

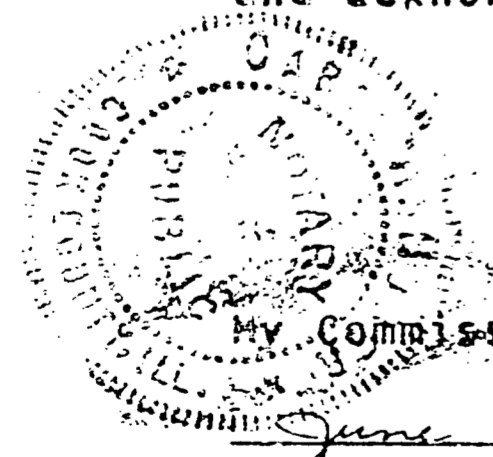
