Sealed with our seals, and dated this 17th day of February A. D. 1969. The condition of the above obligation is as follows, viz.:

NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH,

WHEREAS, the above named and bounden Edward J. Phillips has been duly elected and commissioned or appointed Police Commissioner, Town of Munster in and for Lake County, in the State of Indiana, aforesaid, for the term beginning from the 17th day of February A. D. 1969 and until his successor is duly qualified.

Now, if the said Edward J. Phillips shall faithfully perform and discharge his duties as such Police Commissioner and pay over on demand to the persons entitled or authorized to receive the same, all moneys that may come into his hands as such Police Commissioner during his continuance in office; and further, that the Legislature may change, modify or repeal any law now in force, and exact any and all laws during the existence of the above obligation at the pleasure of the Legislature, without in any way or manner releasing the said officer or his said securities on said bond; then, and in that case, the above obligation shall cease, be null and void, otherwise to be and to remain in full force and virtue in law.
