



- 2. That she and her now deceased husband, Leonard J. Daily, were husband and wife, at the time they acquired title as tenants by the entireties to said real estate by deed of conveyance dated March 12, 1960.
- 3. That the marital relationship which existed between said affiant and Leonard J. Daily, her husband, continued unbroken from the time they so acquired title to said real estate until the death of her said husband on November 21, 1965, at which time this affiant acquired title to said real estate as surviving tenant by the entireties.
- 4. That Leonard J. Daily died leaving a Last Will and Testament that has never been probated; that there has never been any administration upon the estate of the said Leonard J. Daily; that the gross value of the estate of the said Leonard J. Daily, deceased, taking into consideration in the evaluation thereof, the value of all his gifts in contem-

plation of death, including all firsts made by him in the three years next preceding his death, together with the value of all investments in joint properties and estates by the entireties, including the real estate above described, plus the proceeds of all insurance on his life, did not equal or exceed the sum of \$60,000.00, as a consequence of which his estate was not subject to Federal Estate Tax.
