3. VOTING WENDERS shall be such male communicant members as have reached the age of twenty-one years and have been received into voting membership by resolution of the Voters Assembly.

The voting members shall constitute the VOTERS ASSESSLY. As a body the Voters Assembly shall have supreme authority to manage and direct all spiritual and material affairs of this Church.

Voting members shall have the privilege of the floor and the right to vote in all
