- 2. The parties hereto agree that the Option is of no further force and effect and may be disregarded by all persons dealing with title to the Property.

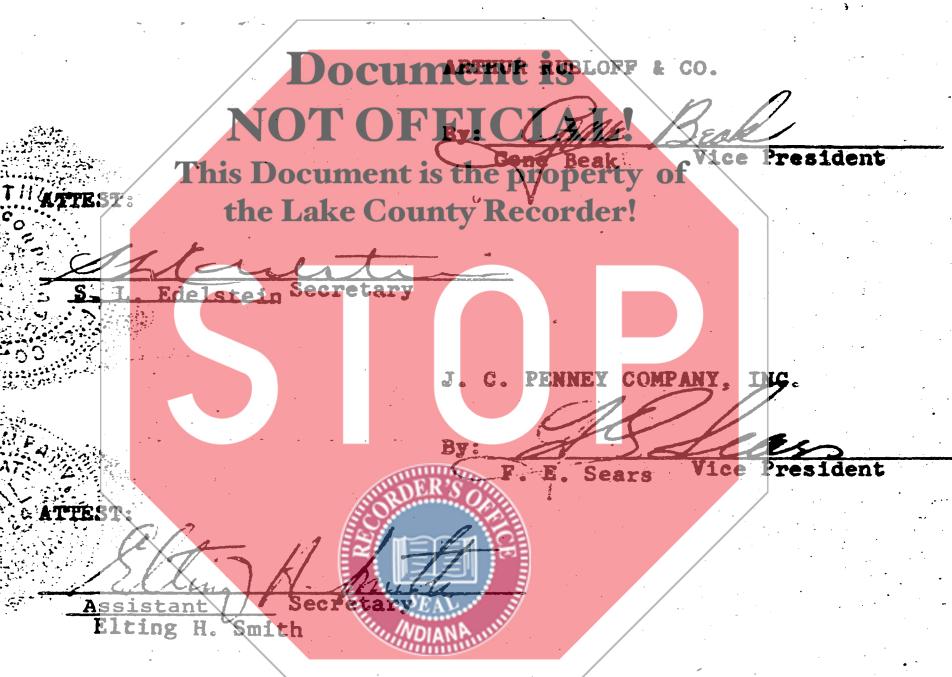
