doing business in the State of Indiana, with office at 211 West Washington Avenue, South
Bend, Indiana, 46601, as SURETY, are held and firmly bound unto LAKE COUNTY AND ANY OTHER
CITY OR TOWN THEREIN, as OBLIGEE, in the aggregate sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS
(\$5,000.00), for which sum well and truly to be paid, said PRINCIPAL and SURETY bind them-
selves jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH THAT,

WHEREAS, the above bounden PRINCIPAL is desirous of obtaining a license from LAKE
COUNTY AND ANY OTHER CITY OR TOWN THEREIN to carry on business as Heating Contractor

NOW, THEREFORE, if the said PRINCIPAL shall, during the term ending on the 31st day
of December, 1980, faithfully observe and honestly comply with the provisions of all
Ordinances of LAKE COUNTY AND ANY OTHER CITY OR TOWN THEREIN regulating Heating
Contractors, then this obligation shall become void; otherwise to remain in full force
and effect.

executed by the SURETY and PRINCIPAL hereon.

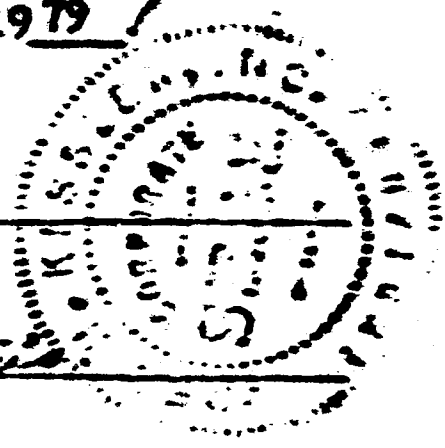

POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That THE TRAVELERS INDEMNITY COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Connecticut, does hereby make, constitute and appoint

Lillian Cinkowski, Gilbert O. Johnson, John H. Mackey, Jane Olston, E. Donald Peterson, Pamela L. Buschmeyer, all of South Bend, Indiana, EACH

its true and lawful Attorney(s) in fact, with full power and authority, for and on behalf of the Company as surety, to execute and deliver and affix the seal of the Company thereto, if a seal is required, bonds, undertakings, recognizances, consents of surety or other written obligations in the nature thereof, as follows:

Any and all bonds, undertakings, recognizances, consents of surety or other written obligations in the nature thereof

and to bind THE TRAVELERS INDEMNITY COMPANY thereby, and all of the acts of said Attorney(s) in fact, pursuant to these presents, are hereby ratified and confirmed. This appointment is made under and by authority of the following by-laws of the Company which by-laws are now in full force and effect:

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 14. The Chairman of the Board, the President, the Chairman of the Finance Committee, any Executive Vice President, any Senior Vice President, any Vice President, any Second Vice President, the Corporate Secretary or any Department Secretary may appoint attorneys-in-fact or agents with power and authority, as defined or limited in their respective powers of attorney, for and on behalf of the Company to execute and deliver, and affix the seal of the Company thereto, bonds, undertakings, recognizances, consents of surety or other written obligations in the nature thereof and any of said officers may remove any such attorney-in-fact or agent and revoke the power and authority given to him.

ARTICLE IV, SECTION 16. Any bond, undertaking, recognizance, consent of surety or written obligation in the nature thereof shall be valid and binding upon the Company when signed by the Chairman of the Board, the President, the Chairman of the Finance Committee, any Executive Vice President, any Senior Vice President, any Vice President or any Second Vice President and duly attested and sealed, if a seal is required, by the Corporate Secretary or any Department Secretary or any Assistant Corporate Secretary or any Assistant Department Secretary, or shall be valid and binding upon the Company when duly executed and sealed, if a seal is required, by a duly authorized attorney-in-fact or agent, executed to and within the limits of the authority granted by his or her power of attorney.

This power of attorney is signed and sealed by facsimile under and by the authority of the following Resolution adopted by the Directors of THE TRAVELERS INDEMNITY COMPANY at a meeting duly called and held on the 30th day of November, 1959:

Voted: That the signature of any officer authorized by the By-Laws and the Company seal may be affixed by facsimile to any power of attorney or special power of attorney or certification of either given for the execution of any bond, undertaking, recognizance or other written obligation in the nature thereof; such signature and seal, when so used being hereby adopted by the Company as the original signature of such officer and the original seal of the Company, to be valid and binding upon the Company with the same force and effect as though manually affixed.
