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- 1. He is the owner of said promises in fee simple or such other courts as is stated bersin.

Any descionsy in the amount of such aggregate messally payment shall, unless made good by the Mortgages prior to the due date of the next such payment, constitute an event of default under this mortgage. At Mortgages's option, Mortgages will pay a "late charge" not exceeding four percentum (4%) of any installment when paid more than fifteen (15) days after the due date thereof to cover the extra expense involved in handling delinquent payments, but such "late charge" shall not be payable out of the proceeds of any sale made to entirely the indebtedness secured hereby, unless such proceeds are sufficient to directory the entire indebtedness and all proper costs and expenses expenses.

- 4. If the total of the payments made by the Mortgager under (a) of paragraph 3 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgages as trustee for ground rents, taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor for such items or, at Mortgager's option, as trustee, shall be refunded to Mortgagor.
