Virginianis, that for the consideration bereinafter stated, receipt of which is bereby ecknowledged, the martgages does bereby mertgage, sell, great, assign, and convey unce the martgages, his veccesses and assign, all of the following described property situated and being in the County of Lake.

## 1. The mertpager covenants and agrees as fellows:

- e. He will premiptly pay the indebtedness evidenced by said premissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided
- b. He will pay all texus, measurements, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, from or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and will precaptly deliver the efficial receipts therefor to the said mortgages.
- c. He will pay such expenses and fees as may be incurred in the presention and maintenance of said property, including the fees of any attorney employed by the mortgages for the collection of any or all of the indebtedness hereby sourced, or for foreclosure by mortgages's sais, or court proceedings, or in any other litigation or proceeding affecting said premises. Attorneyo' fees reasonably incurred in any other way shall be paid by the mortgages.
- d. For botter receiver of the indebtedness hereby secured, upon the request of the mortgages, its successors or assigns, he shall execute and deliver a supplemental mortgage or mortgages covering any additions, improvements, or betterments made to the property hereinabove described and all property acquired by it after the date hereof (all in form satisfactory to mortgages). - e. The rights created by this conveyance shall remain in full force and effect during any postponement or extension of the time of payment of the indebtedness evidenced by said prominery note or any part thereof secured hereby.
- f. He will continuously maintain basard insurance, of such type or types and in such amounts so the mortgages may from time to time require on the improvements now or hereafter on said property, and will pay promptly when due any premiume therefor. All insurance shall be carried in companies acceptable to mertgages and the policies and resewals thereof shall be held by mortgages and have attached thereo-less payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the mertgages. In event of less, mertgages will give immediate notice in writing to mertgages, and mortgages may make proof of less if not made promptly by mertgages, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such-less directly to mortgages instead of to mertgages and mortgages jointly, and the insurance proceeds, or any part-thereof, may be applied by mortgages at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness bereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged or destroyed: In event of forcelessare of this-mortgage, or other transfer of title to said property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title, and interest of the mertgages in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or mertgages or, at the option of the mertgages, may be currendered for a refund.

All awards of damages in connection with any condemnation for public use of or injury to any of the property subject to this mortgage are hereby soughed and shall be paid to mortgages, who may apply the same to payment of the installments last due under said note, and mortgages is hereby authorized, in the name of the mortgages, to execute and deliver valid acquittances thereof and to appeal from any such award.

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2. Default in any of the covenants or conditions of this, instrument or of the note or loan agreement secured hereby shall terminate the mertgager's right to present on, use, and enjoyment of the property, at the option of the mertgages or his assigns (it being agreed that the mortgager shall have such right until default).
