ORDERED that RONALD GUDGET be and he is hereby appointed Receiver of the assets of defendant corporation and is hereby directed to qualify as such Receiver by filing his bond payable to the State of Indiana through the Clerk of this court in the sum of \$1000 with at least one (1) surety to be approved by this court, conditional upon the faithful discharge of his duties as such Receiver, and that he thereupon take an oath faithfully to perform his duties as Receiver. Further that said Receiver shall not exercise any of the powers or perform any duties until said bond and oath have been approved and filed by this court.
