ORDER ON FINAL REPORT AND

This cause is now submitted to the Court on the Final Report and Account of Executor and Petition For Its Approval and Settlement, which Report and Account and Petition are as follows: (Here Insert).

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court, having examined the same and being advised thereon, now finds that:

1. The required notice of said Report and Account and Petition and of the hearing thereon was given and the same is now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. ANDREW BOBOWSKI, the decedent herein, died testate, a resident of Dyer, Lake County, Indiana, on May 16, 1979, and his Last Will and Testament was admitted to probate before this Court on June 19, 1979.

3. This Court appointed EDWARD BOBOWSKI as Executor of the decedent's Will and Letters Testamentary were issued to him on June 19, 1979, and since that date he has continued to act in such capacity.

4. The matters and things stated in said Report and Account and Petition are true and the Executor has accounted for all the assets of said estate coming into his hands.

5. More than five (5) months have passed since the date of the first published notice to the legatees and creditors of the estate; all claims filed against the estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Executor were employers of labor within the definition of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all state and federal income taxes, if any, and inheritance taxes have been paid. The decedent's estate was not subject to the Federal Estate Tax.

6. Distribution has been made to the legatee under Paragraph V of the decedent's Will.

1. The Final Report and Accounting of the Executor is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed, and the Executor is hereby released and discharged from any further liability and responsibility, together with his surety, as said Executor.
