- 1. The Mortgager will keep all improvements now an said premises, or hereafter erected thereon in a good state of repair and will not permit any waste thereon and will neither do not permit to be done upon said premises anything that might tend to diminish the value thereof.
- 2. That Mortgagor will pay, before the same become delinquent, all taxes, charges and assessments of every kind that may be levied on said premises or any part thereof.

- 3. That Mortgagor will keep all buildings which are now or may hereafter be placed on said premises, continuously insured against fire, windstorm and such other perils as Mortgagee may require, in such company or companies, and in such form as may be satisfactory to Mortgagee, and in such amount as the Mortgagee may from time to time direct; such policy or policies of insurance to be payable to Mortgagee as its interest may appear and delivered to and held by Mortgagee until the indebtedness hereby secured has been fully paid. In the event of loss or damage, the proceeds of said insurance shall be applied upon the indebtedness hereby secured, in such manner as the Mortgagee may elect, even though the same is not yet due, or the Mortgagee's option may be used for the purpose of making repairs or improvements upon the martgaged premises,
- 4. That, in order more fully to protect the security of this marriage, the marriager will pay to the marriagee, on the first of each month until the nate secured hereby is fully paid, a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazards insurance covering marriaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the marriaged property (all as estimated by the marriagee) less all sums already paid therefore, divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by marriagee in trust to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. If the payments made by the marriager shall exceed the amount of payment actually made by the marriagee for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums as the case may be, such excess shall be credited by the marriagee on subsequent payments to be made the marriagear. If, however, the monthly payments made by the marriager shall not be sufficient to pay taxes and assessments and insurance premiums as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, then the marriagear shall pay to the marriages any amount necessary to make up the deficiency on or before the date when such payment of such taxes, assessments or insurance premiums shall be due.
- 5. That in case the Mortgagar fails to pay any tax, or assessment, or fails to keep the buildings on said premises in good repair and insured as above provided, the Mortgagee may pay such taxes, or assessments, or may redeem said premises from sale for taxes or assessments, make repairs or procure insurance, and may pay, remove or discharge any claim, lien or encumbrance, or may purchase any tax title or claim against said premises, and protect the title and possession thereof, in order to preserve the priority of the lien of this mortgage thereon, and may employ attorneys at law to perform any service connected with the mortgage, or to prosecute or defend any suit affecting or involving this mortgage or the title or passession of said premises, and that all maneys paid for any such purpose and all maneys paid out by the Mortgagee to protect the lien of this mortgage and the security intended to be effected hereby, shall be immediately due and payable with interest thereon at the rate of SOUTTAGE per cent (14 %) and become so much additional indebtedness, secured by this mortgage, provided, however, that it shall not be obligatory upon the Mortgagee to advance funds for any of the purposes aforesaid, or to inquire into the validity of such taxes or assessments, or tax sale (the receipts of the proper afficers being conclusive evidence of the validity and amount thereof) or into the necessity of such repairs.
- 6. That if default be made in the performance of any of the covenants or agreements herein or in said note... cantained, an the part of the Mortgagar to be kept and performed, then the whole of said indebtedness secured hereby, including all payments for liens, taxes, assessments, insurance, attorneys' fees, casts, charges or expenses, shall at the election of the Mortgagee, and without notice of such election, at once become and be due and payable at the place of payment aforesaid, anything in said note or herein to the contrary natwithstanding and thereupon the Mortgagee shall have the right (either with or without process of law, using such force as may be necessary) to enter upon and passess, hold and enjoy said property, and to lease the same or any part thereof upon such terms as it shall deem best, and to collect and receive all the rents, issues and profits thereof, and to make alterations, improvements and require, insurance, pay taxes, assessments and do all such other things as may be deemed necessary for the proper protection of the property; and the Mortgagee shall have the right to forestose this mortgage and shall have all the other rights and remedies that the law provides. In the event that any payment provided for in the nate... secured hereby shall become averdue for a period in excess of fifteen (15) days, the Mortgagor agrees to pay a "late charge" of two cents (2c) (not to exceed two cents (2c)) for each dollar (\$1) so overdue, for the purpose of defraying the expense incident to handling the delinquent payment.
- 7. That upon commencement of any foredosure, or at any time thereafter, and prior to the expiration of the time for redemption from any sale of said premises on foredosure, any court of competent jurisdiction, upon application of the Morigagee, may appoint a receiver for said premises to take passession thereof, to collect the rents, issues and profits therefrom during the pendency of such foreclosure, and until the time to redeem the same from foreclosure sale shall have expired, and out of rents, issues and profits, to make necessary repairs and to keep the said premises in proper condition and repair, and to pay all taxes, or assessments, to redeem from tax or assessment sales, to pay insurance premiums necessary to keep said premises insured in accordance with the provisions of this mortgage and to pay the expense of the receivership, and said receiver shall apply the net proceeds to the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and such receiver shall have all the other usual powers of receivers in such cases.
- 8. That in case suit be brought to foreclose this mortgage a reasonable sum shall be allowed to the Martgagee in such proceeding for attarney's fees, title or other expense incident to such foreclosure proceeding, which several sums shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall be recoverable as such whether the suit proceeds to decree or not and shall be included in the decree entered in such foreclosure.

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- 9. That the Martgagee, at its option, may extend the maturity of the note and indeptedness secured nereby, or any balance due therean, from time to time, upon written agreement executed by the Martgager, for such further periods, at such rate of interest, and upon such conditions as may then be agreed upon, and no such extension, and no forbearance or delay of the Martgagee in enforcing any of the provisions of this indenture, shall operate to impair the lien thereof or waive any rights accrued or that might accrue hereunder.
- 10. That in the event the mortgaged property or any part thereof, be taken by condemnation, the Mortgagee is hereby empowered to collect and receive all compensation which may be paid for damages to any property not taken, and all condemnation maney so received shall at Mortgagee's election, be applied either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured, or to the reagir and restoration of any property so damaged, provided that any excess over the amount of the indebtedness shall be delivered to the Mortgagor.
- 11. That Martgagar hereby assigns to Martgagee as additional and collateral security for the indebtedness hereinbefore described, all of the rents, issues and profits accruing under any leases now an said property, or which may hereafter be placed thereon, and all lessees or sub-lessees are hereby directed, upon delinand of Martgagee, to pay said rents, issues and profits direct to Martgagee, this assignment to become null and void upon release of this martgage, PROVIDED, however, this assignment shall become effective only upon default by Martgagor in making payment of any installment of the nate.... hereby secured or in the performance of any of the terms and conditions of this martgage.
- 12. That Marigagor will not convey the marigaged premises so long as any part of the indebtedness hereby secured remains unpaid, without the written consent of the Marigagee, and that a violation of this provision will, at the option of the Marigagee and without notice, accelerate maturity of the indebtedness hereby secured and cause the entire unpaid balance thereof to become immediately due and payable.
- 13. That each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagee is aimulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagee, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith, that no waiver by the Mortgagee of performance of any covenant herein or in said obligation contained shall thereafter in any manner affect the right of Mortgagee to require or enforce performance of the same or any other of said covenants; that whenever the context hereof requires, the masculine gender, as used herein, shall include the feminine and the neuter and the singular number, as used herein, shall include the plural; that all rights and obligations under this mortgage shall extend to and be binding upon the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Mortgagee; and that the powers herein metrianed may be exercised as often as occasion therefor arises.
