And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons in said Estate and the same are now properly before the final action thereon.
2. That Lillian Mayes, died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 21st day of June, 1978, and said Administratrix was issued letters of administration on the 11th day of July, 1978, and since that date she has continued to serve in said capacity.
3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said Administratrix has accounted for all of the assets in this Estate coming into her hands.
4. That more than five (5) months has elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said Estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor her Administratrix was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance

taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said Estate have been paid.

5. That the decedent died leaving the following heirs at law pursuant to the provisions of the Indiana Code, IC 29-1-2-1: Helen Aaron, sister of the decedent, and Jimmy Meadows, brother of the decedent; and that said decedent died a widow, leaving no children nor descendants of any predeceased child or children.

6. That said decedent owned a parcel of real estate located at 2194 Nichols Place, Gary, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Administratrix's hands for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy, the following described real estate, to-wit:

4. Said Administratrix having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached vouchers evidencing said distribution to the decedent's heirs, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

5. Said Administratrix is hereby directed to file her Supplemental Report showing that she has complied with the terms of this Order and that said Administratrix has in all things carried out the provisions of this final decree.
