ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation is REINER ROLLER RINK, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

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personal property of any and every class and description:

3. To purchase, take, hold, own, mortgage or otherwise lien, lease, sell, assign, exchange, convey, transfer or in any manner whatever deal in and dispose of real property;

4. To acquire the good will, rights and property and to undertake the whole or any part of the assets and liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation; to pay for the same in cash, stock of the Corporation, bonds or otherwise; to hold or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so purchased; to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of any business so acquired and to exercise all the powers necessary or convenient in and about the conduct and management of such business;

5.
