ORDER APPROVING ADMINISTRATOR'S FINAL REPORT
AND ACCOUNTING, PETITION TO ALLOW ACCOUNTING, AND
PETITION FOR ORDER APPROVING DISTRIBUTION AND
CLOSING ESTATE

This cause came to be heard on the 7th day of January,
1981, upon the Final Account, Petition to Settle and Allow Account,
and for Authority to Distribute Estate, filed by Jake W. Rubin,
as Administrator of the Estate of Paula L. Otterman, deceased,
which Account and Petition are in the words and figures following,
to-wit: (H.I.)

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto, and
the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said Account and Petition,
and of the Hearing on the same were given to all persons interested
in said Estate and the same are now properly before the Court for
final action thereon.
2. That Paula L. Otterman died intestate, a resident of the
County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 2nd day of February, 1979,
and said Administrator was issued Letters of Administration on the
14th day of February, 1979, and since that date he has continued
to serve in such capacity.
3. That the matters and things stated in said Account and
Petition are true, and that said Administrator has accounted for
all of the assets in this Estate coming into his hands.
4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date
of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said

Decedent; all claims filed against said Estate have been paid and discharged; neither said Decedent or her Administrator were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all Estate taxes, Inheritance taxes, and Gross Income taxes, if any, assessed in said Estate have been paid.

5. That the Decedent died leaving the following heir at law pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code, I.C. 29-1-2-1, co-wit:

THOMAS E. OTTERMAN, a minor son,

and that said Decedent died unmarried, leaving no other child or children, nor descendants of any predeceased child or children, other than those enumerated above.

6. That the Decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at and legally described as:

Building No. 15 - Unit 2 - In the Colonies of Merrillville Condominium, as recorded in Plat Book 44, Page 29, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana, 15-23-280

and that upon the death of said Decedent, said real estate vested by the laws of intestacy in Thomas E. Otterman, a minor son, that a copy of this Decree showing the vesting of said real estate should be recorded in the Office of the Lake County Recorder, in which said real estate is located.

That the deficit shown in said Administrator's Final Report was made up and paid for by the Decedent's relatives, on behalf of the minor beneficiary. Therefore, there is no need to sell real estate to pay said expenses. That no claims have been filed in said Estate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Report and Account of said Administrator is hereby in all things approved, settled, and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Administrator's hands for distribution should be

made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the Final Accounting and is hereby in all things approved.

3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:

Building No. 15 - Unit 2 - In the Colonies of Merrillville Condominium, as recorded in Plat Book 44, Page 29, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana,


is hereby vested in Thomas E. Otterman, a minor son of the deceased.

4. That there were no other assets remaining in the Estate with which to distribute to the said heir of the Decedent.

5. There being no other assets remaining to distribute, said Report and Account is hereby approved and confirmed.

6. Said Administrator is hereby released from any further liability or responsibility along with his surety, as said Administrator of the Estate of Paula L. Otterman.
