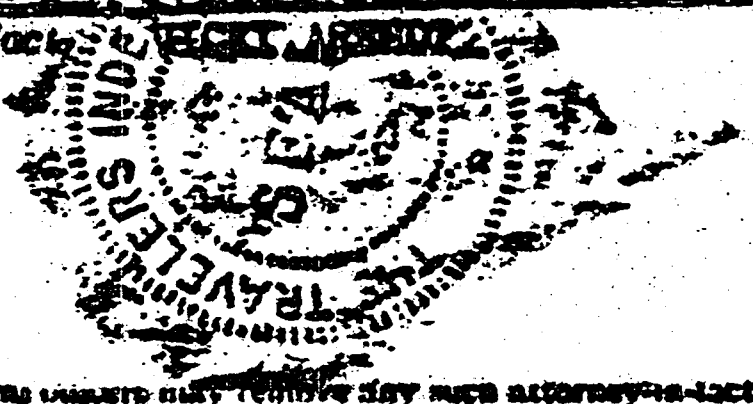

Article IV, Section 16. Any bond, undertaking, recognizance, consent of surety or written obligation in the
