husband & wife ______ of ____ Lake ____ County, in the State of Indiana, hereby mortgage and warrant to the Lowell National Bank. Lake County, Indiana, the following described property in the County of ______ and State of ______ Indiana _____, to wit:

Part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 34 North, Range 8 West of the 2nd P.M. in the City of Crown Point, Lake County, Indiana more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Southerly line of lands of Erie Railroad Company with the Easterly line of Thomas Street (63 feet wide) distant 125 feet Southwesterly by radial measurement from the original center line of Erie Railroad, thence

- (1) Northwardly along said Easterly line of Thomas Street 90 feet, more or less, to a point distant 49.50 feet Southwesterly by radial measurement from said original center line of railroad, thence
- (2) Southeastwardly concentric with and 49.50 feet Southwesterly by radial measurement from said original center line of railroad, 416 feet, more or less; thence
- (3) Southwestwardly 75.50 feet to a point in said Southerly line of lands of Erie Railroad Company distant 375.00 feet, more or less, as measured Southeastwardly along said Southerly line from said Easterly line of Thomas Street, and being also distant 125.00 feet Southwesterly by radial measurement from said original center line of railroad, thence
- (4) Northwestwardly, and along said Southerly line of lands of Erie Railroad Company 375 feet, more or less, to the point or place of beginning and being part of the first of two areas of land and premises described in and conveyed by those two certain deeds, to-wit:
