And there being no objections filed to said final Account, said final Account is now submitted to the Court for final action, and the Court, having seen and examined said final Account and the exhibits attached thereto and being duly advised in the premises, now finds that all persons interested in this estate have been duly notified and that this final Account is now properly before the Court for consideration thereof and action thereon by the Court.

The Court further finds that Hazel Sykes Frank died a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on March 17, 1977, leaving a Last Will and Testament dated April 25, 1963, and that on April 1, 1977, said Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate and Edith E. Dorman and William F. Sykes were duly appointed as the Co-Executors thereof, did qualify, post bond, and since said date, have been acting as such Co-Executors.

The Court further finds that more than five (5) months has elapsed since the date of the first publication of notice to the heirs and creditors herein; that all claims filed against this estate have been paid and discharged; that all debts and expenses of the decedent have been paid and discharged; that neither the decedent nor said Co-Executors as such were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act.

the Court further finds that the inheritance tax due to the State of Indiana on the decedent's estate in the net amount of \$23,119.40 has been paid in full as shown by the countersigned receipt therefor filed with the Final Account. The Court further finds that a federal estate tax return was filed by the estate, that a closing letter has been issued by the Internal Revenue Service finding a federal estate tax due from this estate in the amount of \$158,846.56, and that such amount has been paid as shown by the receipted vouchers therefor filed with the Final Account. The Court further finds that all federal and state income taxes due from the decedent and from this estate have been paid.

The Court further finds that all of the acts done and performed by the Co-Executors herein should in all things be approved and that this estate and the assets therein have been fully administered. The Court further finds that all allegations and statements contained in said final Account are true and that all costs of administration, including court costs, have been paid in full.

The Court further finds that Edith E. Dorman and William F. Sykes have waived any fees for their services as Co-Executors and that the Co-Executors have paid Thomas, Burke, Dyerly & Cuppy the sum of \$10,250.00 for services as attorneys for the estate.
