Kipper, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed there to and the Court being fully advised in the premises finds that:

- 1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
- 2. That Bertha L. Kipper, died intestate, a resident of the County of Lake. State of Indiana, on the 17th day of April, 1980, and said administratrix was issued Letters of Auministration on the 5th day of June, 1980, to her and since that date she has continued to serve in such capacity.
- 3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said administratrix has account obtained for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.

been paid and discharged; all estate taxes and inheritance taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

- 5. That the decedent died leaving the following heirs at law pursuant to the provisions of Indiana Code, I.C. 29-1-2-1, Laura Springman, daughter and Marcella Durbin, daughter, and that said decedent died a widow leaving no other child or children, nor descendants of any predeceased child or children, other than those enumerated above.
- 6. That a reasonable fee for the administratrix is \$1,800.00 and a reasonable fee for attorney, Richard E. Anderson, the attorney for the estate is \$4,250.00.
- 7. That the decedent owned a vacant piece of real estate located adjacent to 416 West Ridge Boad, Hobart, Lake County, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

Lot 62 in H. & S. Addition to Hobart as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 13 page 12, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.

and that upon the death of said decedent, said real estate vested by the laws of intestacy in Laura Springman, daughter, and Marcella Durbin, daughter, as tenants in common. That the property located at 416 West Ridge Road, Hobart, Indiana, owned by the decedent at the time of her death was sold during the administration of the estate.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED. ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

- i. Said final Report and Account of said administratrix is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
- 2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said administratrix's hands for distribution should be made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting and is hereby in all things approved.
- 3. That oursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lot 82 in H. & S. Addition to Hobart as per plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 13 page 12, in the Office of the Recorder of Lake County, Indiana.



is hereby vested in Laura Springman and Marcella Durbin, as tenants in common.

- 4. That the payment of the administratrix's fee in the sum of \$1,800.00, and the attorney fees in the sum of \$4,250.00 is approved.
- 5. Said administratrix is hereby directed to cash all of the savings bonds in the names of the decedent,
 Bertha L. Kipper, and Joseph Kipper who died 2-3-72, and to distribute them according to Paragraph 6 of this order.
- 6. Said administratrix is hereby directed to distribute and pay over the balance of the estate in her hands for distribution as follows:
