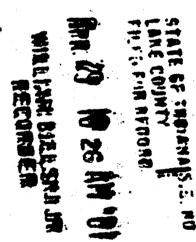

(hereinafter called "Mortgagor"), Mortgage... and Warrant... to MERCANTILE NATIONAL BANK OF INDIANA. Hammond, Indiana, a National Banking Association, organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the United States of America (hereinafter called "Mortgagea") the following described real estate, to-with

Part of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 36, Township 37 North, Range 10 West of the 2nd Principal Meridian, described as: Commencing at the point of intersection of the centerline of Hohman Avenue with the center line of Russell Street as shown from the recorded plat of Towle and Young's Addition to the Town, now City of Hammond, and running thence South along the centerline of said Hohman Avenue 71 feet; thence East 180 feet; thence North 71 feet to the center line of said Russell Street; thence West along the center line of said Russell Street 180 feet to the place of beginning, in the City of Hammond, Lake County, Indiana



- 1. The Mertgagar will keep all improvements now on said premises, or hereafter erected thereon in a good state of repair and will not permit any waste thereon and will neither do nor permit to be done upon said premises anything that might tend to diminish the value thereof.
- 2. That Mortgagor will pay, before the same become delinquent, all taxes, charges and assessments of every kind that may be levied on said premises or any part thereof.

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- 3. That Marigagar will keep all buildings which are now or may hereafter be placed on said premises, continuously insured against fire, windstorm and such other perils as Marigagee may require, in such company or companies, and in such form as may be satisfactory to Marigagee, and in such amount as the Marigagee may from time to time direct; such policy or policies of insurance to be payable to Marigagee as its interest may appear and delivered to and held by Marigagee until the indebtedness hereby secured has been fully paid. In the event of loss or damage, the proceeds of said insurance shall be applied upon the indebtedness hereby secured. In such manner as the Marigagee may elect, even though the same is not yet due, or the Marigagee's aption may be used for the purpose of making repairs or improvements upon the marigaged premises.
- A. That, in order more fully to protect the security of this mortgage, the mortgager will pay to the mortgages, on the first of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of fire and other hazards insurance cavering mortgaged property, plus taxes and assessments next due on the mortgaged property (all as estimated by the mortgages) less all sums already paid therefore, divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes and assessments will become delinquent, such sums to be held by mortgages in trust to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. If the payments mode by the mortgager shall exceed the amount of payment actually made by the mortgages for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums as the case may be, such excess shall be credited by the mortgages on subsequent payments to be made the mortgager. If, however, the monthly payments made by the mortgager shall not be sufficient to pay taxes and assessments and insurance premiums as the case may be, when the same shall become due and payable, then the mortgager shall pay to the mortgages any amount necessary to make up the deficiency on or before the date when such payment of such taxes, assessments or insurance premiums shall be due.
- 6. That if default be made in the performance of any of the covenants or agreements herein or in said nate.... contained, on the part of the Mortgagor to be kept and performed, then the whole of said indebtedness secured hereby, including all payments for items, taxes, assessments, insurance, atterneys' fees, costs, charges or expenses, shall at the election of the Mortgages, and without notice of such election, at once become and be due and payable at the place of payment aforesaid, anything in said note or herein to the contrary notwithstanding and thereupon the Mortgages shall have the right (either with or without process of law, using such force as may be necessary) to enter upon and possess, hold and enjoy said property, and to lease the same or any part thereof upon such terms as it shall deem best, and to collect and receive all the rents, issues and profits thereof, and to make alterations, improvements and repairs, effect insurance, pay taxes, assessments and do all such other things as may be deemed necessary for the proper protection of the property, and the Mortgagoe shall have the right to foreclose this mortgage and shall have all the other rights and remedies that the law provides. In the event that any payment provided for in the nate.... secured hereby shall become averdue for a period in excess of fifteen (15) days, the Mortgagor agrees to pay a "late charge" of two cents (2c) (not to exceed two cents (2c)) for each dollar (\$1) so overdue, for the purpose of defraying the expense incident to handling the delinquent payment.
- 7. That upon commencement of any foreclasure, or at any time thereafter, and prior to the expiration of the time for redemption from any sale of said premises on foreclasure, any court of competent jurisdiction, upon application of the Mortgages, may appoint a receiver for said premises to take passession thereof, to collect the rents, issues and profits therefrom during the pendency of such foreclasure, and until the time to redeem the same from foreclasure sale shall have expired, and out of rents, issues and profits, to make necessary repairs and to keep the said premises in proper condition and repair, and to pay all taxes, or assessments, to redeem from tax or assessment sales, to pay insurance premiums necessary to keep said premises insured in accordance with the provisions of this mortgage and to pay the expense of the receivership, and said receiver shall apply the net proceeds to the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby, and such receiver shall have all the other usual powers of receivers in such cases.
- 8. That In case suit be brought to foreclose this mortgage a reasonable sum shall be allowed to the Mortgages-In such proceeding for attorney's fees, title or other expense incident to such foreclosure proceeding, which several sums shall be so much additional indebtedness secured hereby, and shall be recoverable as such whether the suit proceeds to decree or not and shall be included in the decree entered in such foreclosure.



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9.	That t	he Mort	gagee, at	its option	, may	extend	the	maturity	of t	he nate	and	indebtedn	ess secure
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hereunder.

- 10. That in the event the mortgaged property or any part thereof, be taken by condemnation, the Mortgages is hereby empowered to collect and receive all compensation which may be paid for damages to any property not taken, and all condemnation money so received shall at Mortgages's election, be applied either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured, or to the repair and restoration of any property so damaged, provided that any excess over the amount of the indebtedness shall be delivered to the Mortgagos.
- 11. That Mortgagor hereby assigns to Mortgagee as additional and collateral security for the indebtedness hereinbefore described, all of the rents, issues and profits accruing under any leases now on said property, or which may hereafter be placed thereon, and all lessees or sub-lessees are hereby directed, upon demand of Mortgagee, to pay said rents, issues and profits direct to Mortgagee, this assignment to become null and void upon release of this mortgage, PROVIDED, however, this assignment shall become effective only upon default by Mortgagor in making payment of any installment of the note.... hereby secured or in the performance of any of the terms and conditions of this mortgage.
- 12. That Mortgagar will not convey the mortgaged premises so long as any part of the indebtedness hereby secured remains unpaid, without the written consent of the Mortgages, and that a violation of this provision will, at the aption of the Mortgages and without notice, accelerate maturity of the indebtedness hereby secured and cause the entire unpaid balance thereof to become immediately due and payable.
- 13. That each right, power and remedy herein conferred upon the Mortgagee is cumulative of every other right or remedy of the Mortgagee, whether herein or by law conferred, and may be enforced concurrently therewith, that no waiver by the Mortgagee of performance of any covenant herein or in said obligation contained shall thereafter in any manner affect the right of Mortgagee to require or enforce performance of the same or any other of said covenants; that whenever the context hereof requires, the masculine gender, as used herein, shall include the feminine and the neuter and the singular number, as used herein, shall include the plural; that all rights and obligations under this mortgage shall extend to and be binding upon the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the Mortgagee; and that the powers herein mentioned may be exercised as aften as occasion therefor arises.
- 14. This mortgage also secures the payment of any additional loans made by the Mortgages at its option to the Mortgagor from this date and all instruments evidencing the same.
