UNITED STATES MARSHAL'S DEED

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 1th day of 1981, between JOSEPH N. NOVOTNY, United States Marshal for the Northern District of Indiana, by virtue of his office, of the first part, and CALUMET NATIONAL BANK, of the second part, WITNESSETH:

THAT, WHEREAS, at a regular term of the District Court of the United States, held in and for said District, Hammond Division, on the 7th day of February, 1980, said Calumet National Bank Plaintiff, recovered a judgment against Green L. Echols, Small Business Administration and Government Employees Financial Corp. Defendants, for the sum of Twenty Nine Thousand Six Hundred Seventy Five and 38/100 (\$29,675.38) Dollars, with interest at the statutory rate as provided by the laws and statutes of the State of Indiana from the date of said judgment, together with costs and expenses of sale herein, and a Decree for the sale of all the right, title and interest of the Defendants therein in and to the real estate hereinafter described, all without relief whatever from valuation and appraisement laws.

And, afterwards, to-wit: on the 29th day of April, 1980, in pursuance of said advertisement, the said United States Marshal exposed said land to public auction at the Lake County Sheriff's Civil office at the Courthouse, Complex B, at Crown Point, Indiana, and the said Calumet National Bank bid the sum of Thirty Thousand

NOVOTNY, United States Marshal of said district, by virtue of my office, and by force of the Statute in such cases made and provided, for and in consideration of Thirty Thousand One Hundred Seventy Six and 20/100 (\$30,176.20) Dollars, which sum has been paid by the Calumet National Bank with that part of the indebtedness found due said Calumet National Bank, amounting to Thirty Thousand One Hundred Seventy Six and 20/100 (\$30,176.20) Dollars, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, convey, and sell unto the said Calumet National Bank, all the right, title, interest and claim which the said Defendants in said court on the date of sale aforesaid, had in and to the following described tract or parcel of land:
