THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into by and between EDMUND A. MILO and MILDRED A
MILO, Husband and Wife (hereinafter called "Seller") and

WITNESSETH: Seller hereby agrees to and does sell to Buyer, and Buyer hereby agrees to and does purchase from Seller, the following described real estate (including any improvement or improvements now or hereafter

upon the following covenants, terms and conditions:
1. The Purchase Price and Manner of Payment 1. The Purchase Price. As the purchase price for the Real Estate, Buyer agrees to pay to Seller and Seller agrees to accept from Buyer the sum of Fifty-two Thousand Five Hundred
2. The Manner of Payment. The purchase price shall be paid in the following manner: (a) The sum of Eleven Thousand Five Hundred
was paid by Buyer to Seller at the time of the execution and delivery of this contract, and the receipt of such sum is hereby acknowledged by Seller. (b) The sum of Four Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars and Fifty-Nine Cents
shall be paid monthly, beginning November 1, 1981, and on the same date of each month thereafter, until the remainder of the purchase price, with interest as herein provided, has been paid in-full. October 1, 1980, at which time Buyer agrees to have paid the remainder of the balance in full regardless of prevailing interest rates at that time. 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Prepayment of the Purchase Price

Buyer shall have the privilege of paying without penalty, at any time, any sum or sums in addition to the payments herein required. It is agreed that no such prepayments, except payment in full, shall stop the accrual of interest on the amount so paid until the next succeeding computation of interest after such payment is made. Interest shall not accrue after the date on which Buyer makes any payment that constitutes full payment of the purchase price,

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Taxes, Assessments and Insurance

1. Taxes. Buyer agrees to assume and pay the taxes on the Real Estate beginning with the installment payable _ installments of taxes due and payable thereafter.

2. Assessments. Buyer agrees to pay any assessments or charges upon or applying to the Real Estate for public or municipal improvements or services which, after the date of this Agreement, are constructed or installed on or about the Real Estate or otherwise serve the Real Estate.

3. Penalties. Buyer agrees to pay any penalties, whether in the form of interest or otherwise, in connection with the late or untimely payment of such taxes, assessments or charges.

4. Insurance. Buyer agrees to keep the improvements included in the Real Estate insured under fire and extended coverage policies and to pay premiums on such insurance policies as they become due. Such insurance shall be carried in a company or companies approved by Seller and in an amount not less than the balance of the purchase price due hereunder. Such policy or policies shall be issued in the name of Seller and Buyer, as their respective interests may appear, and shall be delivered to and retained by Seller during the continuance of this contract.

5. Seller's Right to Perform Buyer's Covenants. If Buyer fails to perform any act or to make any payment required of him by this Article III, Seller shall have the right at any time, without notice, to perform any such act or to make any such payment, and in exercising such right, to incur necessary and incidental costs and expenses, including attorney fees. Nothing in this provision shall imply any obligation on the part of Seller to perform any act or to make any payment required of Buyer.

The exercise of the right by Seller shall not constitute a release of any obligation of Buyer under this Article III or a waiver of any remedy given Seller under this contract, nor shall such exercise constitute an estoppel to the exercise by Seller of any right or remedy of his for a subsequent failure by Buyer to perform any act or make any payment required by him under this Article III.

Payments made by Seller and all costs and expenses incurred by him in connection with the exercise of such right shall, at the option of Seller, either (a) be payable to Seller by Buyer within 30 days after demand, or (b) be added to principal. In any event such payments and such costs and expenses shall bear interest from the respective dates of making payment or incurring costs and expenses.

Possession

Seller shall deliver to Buyer full and complete possession of the Real Estate ___on or before October 18, 1981 After one (1) days from the date hereof Seller shall pay to Buyer \$25.00 day for each day Seller withholds possession of the Real Estate from Buyer. A title insurance policy furnished under this contract shall be in the amount of the purchase price and shall be issued by an insurer satisfactory to Buyer.

Any further title evidence shall be at the expense of the Buyer, provided, however, that the cost of additional title evidence necessitated by the acts or omissions of Seller or by any judicial proceeding affecting the Real Estate shall be borne by Seller.

Seller covenants and agrees that upon the payment of all sums due under this contract and the prompt and full performance by Buyer of all his covenants and agreements herein made, Seller will convey or cause to be conveyed to Buyer, by Warranty Deed, the above described Real Estate subject to restrictions and easements of record as of a date on or before the date of this contract and all taxes and assessments which ara Buver's obligations.

Seller's Right to Mortgage the Real Estate

. 44 . 4 . 5 Seller shall have the right to obtain, without Buyer's consent, a loan or loans secured by mortgage on the Real Estate, and the right to renew any such loan or loans. Seller agrees, however, that the aggregate principal balances of all such loans shall never exceed the unpaid balance of the purchase price for the Real Estate under this contract. If Seller encumbers the Real Estate by a mortgage, Buyer shall have the right 233 to make any omitted payment or payments and to deduct the amount thereof from payments, due under this contract. Seller agrees, however, that he will pay all such mortgage loans when due or at such time as Buyer pays in full all sums due under this contract, and Seller shall obtain valid releases of all such mortgage loans when they are paid.

Assignment of Contract

Buyer may not sell or assign this contract, Buyer's interest therein, or Buyer's interest in the Real Estate, without the written consent of Seller; provided, however, that any such consent shall not be unreasonably withheld, and that no assignment shall operate to relieve either party from liability hereon.

Use of the Real Estate by Buyer, Seller's Right to Inspection and Buyer's Responsibility for Injuries

- 1. Use. The Real Estate may not without Seller's Written Authorization other than Buyer. Buyer may make alterations, changes and make additional improvements (only with) (swithout) the written consent of Seller having first been obtained. Buyer shall use the Real Estate carefully, and shall keep the same in good repair at his expense. No clause in this contract shall be interpreted so as to create or allow any mechanics, labor, materialmen, or other creditors of Buyer or of an assignce of Buyer to obtain a lien or attachment against Seller's interest herein. Buyer shall not commit waste on the Real Estate. In his occupancy of the Real Estate, Buyer shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations of the United States of America, of the State of Indiana, and of the City and County where the Real Estate is situated. In the event of Buyer's breach of this covenant and a re-entry by Seller, Buyer shall deliver the Real Estate to Seller in as good condition as they are now, ordinary wear and tear, acts of God and public authorities excepted.
- 2. Seller's Right of Inspection. Seller shall have the right to enter and inspect the Real Estate at any reasonable time.
- 3. Buyer's Responsibility for Accidents. As a part of the consideration hereof, Buyer assumes all risk and responsibility for accident or damage to person or property arising from the use of or in or about the Real Estate.

Seller's Remedies on Buyer's Default

Time shall be of the essence of this contract.

- If Buyer fails, neglects or refuses to make any payment under this contract when due or to perform any of Buyer's covenants, terms and conditions when and as required under this contract:
- (1) Seller shall have the right to declare this contract forfeited and terminated, and upon such a declaration, all right, title and interest of Buyer in and to the Real Estate shall immediately cease and Buyer shall then be considered as a tenant holding over without permission and Seller shall be entitled to re-enter and take immediate possession of the Real Estate and to evict Buyer and all persons claiming under him;
- (2) Separately or in conjunction with his right under item (1) above, as Seller may elect, Seller shall have the right to file in a court of competent jurisdiction an action to have this contract forfeited and terminated and to recover from Buyer all or any of the following:
 - (a) possession of the Real Estate;
 - (b) any installments due and unpaid at the time of filing of the action and becoming due and unpaid from that time until possession of the Real Estate is recovered;
 - (c) interest on the principal from the last date to which interest was paid until judgment or possession is recovered by Seller whichever shall occur first; provided, however, that this shall not be construed as allowing Seller to recover any interest which would be included under item (2) (b) above;
 - (d) due and unpaid real estate taxes, assessments, charges and penalties which Buyer is obligated to pay under this contract;
 - (e) premiums due and unpaid for insurance which Buyer is obligated to provide under Article III of this contract;
 - (f) the reasonable cost of repair of any physical damage or waste to the Real Estate other than damage caused by ordinary wear and tear, acts of God and public authorities;
 - (g) any other amounts (other than payment of the purchase price) which Buyer is obligated to pay under this contract.
- (3) In addition to any other remedy under this contract, Seller shall have such other remedies as are available at law or in equity.
- (4) In any case Seller shall have the right to retain (without prejudice to his right to recover any other sums from Buyer, or to have any other remedy, under this contract) all payments made by Buyer to Seller and all sums received by Seller as proceeds of insurance or as other benefits or considerations, in each case made or received under this contract.
- (5) Seller shall have the right to file in a court of competent jurisdiction an action to recover all of the unpaid balance of the purchase price (which upon default by Buyer under this contract shall, at the option of Seller, become immediately due and payable) and interest on such unpaid balance until such unpaid balance is paid, together with any taxes, assessments, charges, penalties and insurance premiums paid by Seller under this contract and interest on such amounts until they are paid, unless such amounts (and interest on them) have been added to principal under this contract.

The exercise or attempted exercise by Seller of any right or remedy available under this contract shall not preclude Seller from exercising any other right or remedy so available, nor shall any such exercise or attempted exercise constitute or be construed to be an election of remedies, so that no such right or remedy shall be exclusive of any other right or remedy, and each and every such right or remedy shall be cumulative and in addition to any other right or remedy available under this contract.

In any judicial proceeding to enforce this contract Buyer specifically waives, to the extent he lawfully may do, his right, if any, to a hearing preliminary to a judicial order for immediate possession of the Real Estate to be granted to Seller under applicable law.

All sums payable under this contract are payable with accrued interest and without relief from valuation or appraisement laws. In addition to any other sum payable by Buyer under this contract, Buyer shall pay any reasonable expense, including attorneys' fees, incurred by Seller in connection with the exercise of any right or remedy under this contract, and the preparation and delivery of notice.

The failure or omission of Seller to enforce any of his right or remedies upon any breach of any of the covenants, terms or conditions of this contract shall not bar or abridge any of his rights or remedies upon any subsequent default.

Before Seller shall pursue any of his rights or remedies under this Article IX, he shall first give Buyer written notice of the default complained of and Buyer shall have ___Sixty (60) ___days from the posting of such notice to correct any default; provided, however __Thirty (30) ____ days' notice shall be required in the case of any default in payment of any monies agreed to be paid by Buyer under this contract.

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General Agreements of Parties

All covenants hereof shall extend to and be obligatory on the heirs, personal representatives, successors and assigns of the parties. When applicable, the singular shall apply to the plural and the masculine to the feminine or the neuter. Any notices to be given hereunder shall be deemed sufficiently given when (1) served on the person to be notified, or (2) placed in an envelope directed to the person to be notified at his last known address and deposited in a United States Post Office mail box postage prepaid.

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RIDER TO CONTRACT FOR CONDITIONAL SALE OF REAL ESTATE BETWEEN EDMUND A. MILO and MILDRED A. MILO, and DENNIS E. KELLEY and DENISE A. NICHOLS.

Article XI.

Automatic Acceleration of Contract Balance

Notwithstanding anything in this agreement to the contrary, the unpaid balance, including accrued interest and other obligations due hereunder, shall be due and payable in full on or before October 1, 1986. At said time, said entire amount of unpaid principal, interest and other obligations shall be fully paid by the Buyer to the Seller, regardless of the prevailing interest rates at that time.

Article XII.

Late Payments

Any monthly installments received by Seller after the tenth day of the month in which they are due are subject to a late charge of four (4%) percent of that month's payment.

Article XIII.

Fire Insurance Proceeds

In the event of a fire or other casualty resulting in payment under policies of insurance herein of a sum in excess of \$2,000.00, the proceeds shall be placed in escrow, to be held by Seller, until the work of repair or replacement is completed, and payment made promptly from said escrow; provided, however, that in the event the proceeds equal or exceed the unpaid balance due from time to time, the Seller shall have the right to retain the proceeds up to the amount sufficient to pay the unpaid balance and all interest and other charges due him. The balance of the proceeds, if any, shall be the property of the Buyer.

In the event the repair or replacement exceeds the amount in escrow, the Buyer shall add an amount to the escrow which is sufficient to make payment in full before any part of the escrow shall be disbursed.

In addition to the foregoing or as a part of it, the Buyer shall purchase and maintain in force a homeowner's insurance policy including not only fire and extended coverage, but general and comprehensive liability for bodily injury and property damage with limits of not less than \$100,000.00 per occurrence. Such homeowner's insurance policy shall be issued in the name of the Seller and Buyer, as their respective interests may appear, and a memorandum thereof shall be delivered to and retained by the Seller during the continuation of this contract.

Article XIV.

Taxes

The real estate taxes unpaid to the May 1982 installment shall be the liability of and be paid for by the Seller. Any and all real estate taxes payable subsequent to the May 1982 installment shall be Buyer's obligation.

Buyer to receive pro rata credit at closing on taxes from July 1, 1981 to September 25, 1981.

The Seller shall estimate, on an annual basis, the monthly payment for real estate taxes. The Buyer agrees to pay, in advance, each month with the payment for the principal and interest, an amount equal to the monthly estimate for real estate taxes; and the Seller agrees to hold and escrow said funds and to apply the same to the payment of taxes. In the event the sums which are in escrow are inadequate to pay the amount of taxes then due and payable, the Buyer agrees forthwith to make such additional deposits as are required to do so.

Article XV.

Proration of Contract Interest

The parties agree that the contract interest accrued during the month of September 1981 is to be prorated. Buyer is to pay interest from September 25, 1981 to September 30, 1981, and shall make payment to Seller in the determined amount at the time of closing.

Article XVI.

Warranty or Guaranty

All personal property including appliances, sold as a part of the real estate, are sold "as is" without warranty or guaranty of any kind whatsoever and further sold without representations as to fitness for the purpose. The Buyer acknowledges that they have examined the personal property and accept the same under the provisions set forth above.

Article XVII.

Indemnity and Hold Harmless

After possession is given by the Seller to the Buyer, the Buyer agrees that the Seller shall not be liable for any injury and damage which may be sustained to any person or any property, including the person or property of the Buyer, and the Buyer agrees to hold the Seller harmless from any claim of any kind with respect to injury or damage to person or property, and further agrees to defend any claim or action brought against the Seller and pay all expenses therefor including attorney's fees and costs.
