3. That pursuant to the laws of intestacy the following described real estate, to-wit:



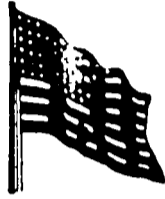
