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EASEMENT FOR UNDERGROUND ELECTRICAL LINES

KNOW ALL MEN, That THE M. W. KELLOGG COMPANY, a Delaware Corporation, formerly known as PULLMAN INCORPORATED, herein called "Grantor", in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, in hand paid to the Grantor, hereby grants to NORTHERN INDIANA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY, an Indiana corporation, herein called "Grantee", and to its successors, an easement, right and authority, from time to time, to install, construct, maintain, operate, repair, replace, renew and remove: (a) underground ducts and conduits, (b) underground wires, cables, conductors, manholes and other necessary appurtenances, in such underground ducts and conduits, (c) pads for transformers, with transformers located thereon, where reasonably necessary in the sole judgment and discretion of Grantee herein together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, for the purposes herein described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from the strip of easement land, over adjoining lands of Grantor, and the right to trim, or at Grantee's option, to cut down and remove from the premises hereinafter described and from the adjoining lands of Grantor any trees or undergrowth, which may, in the sole judgment of Grantee, endanger the safety of, or interfere with the use or enjoyment of, any of Grantee's facilities arising from the F I From b trees or underground root system, including the right to clear and keep FEB 16 1982 such obstructions from the surface and subsurface as may be necessary for the installation and maintenance of such facilities in, upon, along and over a strip of land Levie & Thurs Okatiehtyof way situated in Section 5, Township 36 North, Range 9W of the Second

Principal Meridian, in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, described as follows:

A strip of land in the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 5, Township 36 North, Range 9 West of the 2nd P.M., being the wide, lying 15 feet on each side of said centerline and said centerline produced, said centerline being described as follows:

Beginning at a point of the North right-of-way line of 165th Street said point being 30 feet North of and 60 feet West of the intersection of the centerline of Indianapolis Boulevard and 165th Street, Hammond, Indiana, thence North and parallel to the centerline of Indianapolis Boulevard a distance of 67 feet, to the point of termination, in the City of Hammond, Lake County, Indiana,

to operate by means thereof one or more line or lines for the transmission, distribution and delivery of electrical energy to the public in general to be used for light, heat, power, telephone and other purposes.

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Any underground facilities of the Grantee shall be at least 24 inches below the surface of the soil, as the surface now exists.

The Grantor reserves the use of the above described land not inconsistent with this grant, but no buildings or structures shall be placed on the right of way by Grantor.

The Grantee shall and will indemnify and save the Grantor harmless from and against any and all liability, damage, injuries, losses, claims, demands or costs or expenses, including reasonable attorneys fees, proximately caused by the fault, culpability, or negligence of the Grantee in the construction, erection, maintenance, operation, repair or renewal of said line or lines, underground ducts or conduits, pads for transformers and transformers thereon, and the structures and appurtenances connected therewith.

The undersigned Grantor hereby covenants that as of the date of this grant it is the owner in fee simple of said real estate, lawfully seized thereof, with good right to grant and convey said easement herein, and that the said real estate is subject to that certain perpetual easement created by Declaration of Taking filed by the Secretary of War, United States of America, on October 28, 1944 and amended Declaration of Taking filed February 28, 1945, Cause No. 43 Civil Docket, United States District Court of the Northern District of Indiana, Hammond Division.
