

Last Will and Testament

I, ELEANOR R. FENNESSY, now residing in Lake County, Indiana, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but mindful of the uncertainty of life, do make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me heretofore made, and declaring this and none other to be my Last Will and Testament.

ONE

I direct my Executors to pay out of my estate all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness, and funeral expenses.

TWO

All the rest and residue of my estate, be the same real estate, personal property, or, mixed property, and wherever situate, I hereby give, devise and bequeath, upon my death, to my husband, William J. Fennessy, if he survives me.

THREE

In the event my husband shall die prior to the date of my death, or shall die in a common disaster with me, then and in that event, I do hereby give, devise and bequeath, upon my death, all the rest and residue of my estate, be the same real estate, personal property, or, mixed property, and wherever situate, of which I die possessed, in equal shares, one share to each of my children surviv-

ing me and one share to each group of the then surviving children of a child of mine who has predeceased me.

FOUR

Although it is my understanding that my husband, William J. Fennessy, is or may be executing his Last Will and Testament at or about the time of the execution of this, my Last Will and Testament, it is not my nor our intention that such Wills shall be construed or deemed to be mutual, reciprocal, or dependent one upon the other, and it is not my nor our intention that the freedom of testation of myself and my husband be in any way limited or that the freedom to transfer property during the life of either of us be in any way limited.

FIVE

I hereby name and appoint my husband, William J. Fennessy, to be the Executor of this, my Last Will and Testament, and ask that he be permitted to serve without bond; and should he for any reason fail to act or qualify as such, then I do appoint my daughter, Rita Marie Lamprecht, to act as Successor Executrix.
