JUDGMENT OF QUIET TITLE

Plaintiff, Hoosier State Bank of Indiana, having filed its complaint to quiet title herein on the 17th day of March 1981, and the defendant, Medusa Cement Company, having been served by certified mail on March 20, 1981; the defendant, Stearns Manufacturing Company Inc., having been served by certified mail on March 20, 1981; the defendant, Baker Highway Express Inc., having been served, by certified mail on March 20, 1981; the Treasurer of Lake County Indiana having been served by certified mail on March 19, 1981; and the defendant, Joseph O'Brien, having refused service through his attorneys Murphy and Storey on March 30, 1981, The plaintiff, Hoosier State Bank of Indiana, now moves for default against each of said defendants.

The defendant, Belden Brick, having appeared by its countries. Hodges, Davis Gruenberg, Compton and Sayers, P.C., and having Fired their answer which answer is in the following words and froures, to-wit and this matter having been set for trial on November 24, 1981, this matter is now submitted for trial without the intervention of a jury.

Cause submitted. Evidence heard.

The court being duly advised in the premises now finds that the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Indiana, Hammond Division, sitting at Gary, Indiana, in a cause of action captioned In Re South Hammond Concrete, the same being Bankruptcy No. HB 79-108 entered judgment on the December 28, 1979, which judgment is in the following words and figures, to-wit: insert) and it now appearing that said property, absent sale was to





Inc. on September 30, 1980, and that in fact no sale by the Trustee in Bankruptcy was consumated. The court further finds that no sale consumated by the Trustee in Bankruptcy and pursuant to said judgment said real estate was transferred, set over and released to the secured creditors under the terms of said judgment.

The court further finds that all of the defendants with the exception of Belden Brick Company are in default for having failed to appear, file answer or otherwise respond to plaintiff's complaint.

The court further finds that in the event the parcels of real estate transferred to the Hoosier State Bank of Indiana and others under the terms of said judgment and decree are sold in the aggregate sum of One Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand Forty-Nine and 34/100 Dollars (\$153,049.34) together with interest accrued and accruing subsequent to said date and reasonable expenses of sale, any and all proceeds in excess of said proceeds from said parcel of real estate shall be paid to the defendant, Belden Brick Company.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

- l. That the defendants, Joseph O'Brien, Medusa Cement Company, Stearns Manufacturing Comapany. Inc., Baker Highway Express Inc., and the Treasurer of Lake County, be and are hereby defaulted and determined to have no interest in the parcels of real estate owned by South Hammond Concrete, the legal description of which are attached hereto, made a part hereto and marked as Exhibit "A".
- 2. That the Hoosier State Bank of Indiana be and is the owner in fee simple of said real estate described in Exhibit "A" and is entitled to the quiet and peaceful possessful of said property.
- 3. That the Hoosier State Bank of Indiana rightfully and legally obtained title to the aforesaid real property by virtue of a judgment of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Indiana, Hammond Division sitting at Gary on the 30th day of September, 1980 by virtue of a judgment entered on December 28, 1979 under Cause No. HB 79 108.
- 4. That the claims of Joseph O'Brien, Belden Brick Company, Medusa Cement Company, Stearns Manufacturing Company, Inc., Baker Highway Express Inc., and the Treasurer of Lake County are

Without right, whatever with the exception of the defendant, Belden Brick Company, who shall be entitled to any net proceeds of said parcel of real estate which exceed the sum of One Hundred Firty-Three Thousand Forty-Nine and 34/100 Dollars (\$153,049.34) together with interest accrued and accruing from December 28, 1979.

- 5. That the defendants, and each of them, with the exception of Belden Brick, as identified above are hereby permanently enjoined from ascerting any right, title, claim or interest or lien on said real estate.
- 6. That the title of the Hoosier State Bank of Indiana to said real estate is hereby forever quieted against any and all claims and demands of the defendants, and each of them, except the interest of Belden Brick Company, as identified above, and any persons claiming under or through them.
