ORDER APPROVING CO-EXECUTORS FINAL REPORT AND ACCOUNTINGS,  
PETITION TO ALLOW ACCOUNTING, AND PETITION FOR ORDER  
APPROVING DISTRIBUTION AND CLOSING ESTATE

This cause came to be heard on the 10th day of April, 1982, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account and for authority to distribute estate filed by Joseph Guziar and Veronica Saczawa, as co-executors of the estate of Albert Jendrzejczyk, deceased, which account and petition are in the words and figures following, to-wit:

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing, on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the court for final action thereon.

2. That Albert Jendrzejczyk, died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 2nd day of September, 1980, and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 9th day of September, 1980, and this Court appointed said Joseph Guziar and Veronica Saczawa as co-executors of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and that said co-executors were issued Letters of Testamentary on the 9th day of September, 1980, to them and since that date they have continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said co-executors have accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into their hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his co-executors were employers of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

5. The following persons are the sole legatees and devisees under the decedent's Last Will and Testament: Louise Sobeck, specific bequest, \$3,000.00; Henrietta Guziar, specific bequest, \$1,000.00; Veronica Saczawa, specific bequest, \$1,500.00; Helena Kofka, specific bequest, \$1,000.00; St. Stanislaus Church, specific bequest, \$300.00; Joseph Bochonowski, Specific bequest, \$1,000.00; Joseph Guziar, all residue; and that all assets and property of this estate remaining after payment of decedent's debts and expenses of administration has been distributed to the above named persons as evidenced by Affidavit in Lieu of Vouchers which is attached hereto and made a part of the accounting.

6. That the decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 517 Lewis St., in the County of Lake, State of Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

East One-Half (1/2) of Lot Fifteen (15) and West Twelve and One-Half (12 1/2) feet of Lot Sixteen (16), in Block Three (3), Hink's Addition, Hammond, Lake County, Indiana as the same appears of record in Plat Book 2, page 74, in the Recorder's Office of Lake County, Indiana.

and that said real estate vested in Joseph Guziar upon the decedent's death as part of the residuary estate, and a copy of this decree showing the vesting of said real estate is filed in the office of the County Recorder in which said real estate is located.

1. Said Final Report and Account of said co-executors is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said co-executors hands for distribution has been made pursuant to the distribution set forth in the final accounting as prescribed under the Last will and Testament of said decedent and is hereby in all things approved.
