And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the court being duly advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate, and the same are now properly before the court for final action thereon.

2. That Guadalupe Gomez died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 11th day of March, 1976, and his Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this court on the 16th day of July, 1976, and this court appointed said James Wash as executor of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent; and said executor was issued Letters Testamentary on the 16th day of July, 1976, to him and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.
