ORDER APPROVING ADMINISTRATOR'S WITH WILL

This cause came to be heard on this 25th day of February, 1983, upon the final account, petition to settle and allow account, and for authority to distribute estate filed by Barbara Peterson, as administratrix with will annexed of the estate of John F. And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notices of the filing of said account and petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said estate and the same are now property before the Court for final action thereon.
2. That John F. Schneider died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 15th day of July, 1979, and said administratrix with will annexed was issued Letters of Administration on the 24th day of August, 1979, and since that date has continued to serve in such capacity.
3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true and that said administratrix with will annexed has accounted for all of the assets in this estate coming into her hands.
4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of the first published notice to the heirs and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his administratrix with will annexed was an employer of labor with the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.

3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:



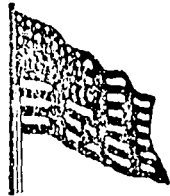
