Provided, that if the Surety shall so elect, this bond may be cancelled by giving thirty (30) days notice in writing to the obligee and this bond shall be deemed cancelled at the expiration of said thirty (30) days; but said Surety so filing said notice shall not be relieved from any liability, claims or demands under this bond or which shall accrue hereunder before the expiration of said thirty (30) day period.

This bond may be continued from year to year by means of a continuation certificate.
