Comes now the petitioner, Wayne Decker, in court in person and by his attorney, James Daugherty, and shows service of summons on the respondent by the Sheriff of Lake County, Indiana, on September 9, 1977, which summons together with the Sheriff's return endorsed thereon reads as follows (here insert).

Comes now the respondent, Virginia Decker, in court in person and by her attorney, David S. Stevens.

Thereupon this cause is submitted to court for hearing and trial, without the intervention of a jury, and the Court having heard and concluded all the evidence and being duly advised in the premises now finds that the marriage of the parties is irretrievably broken and should be dissolved. The Court further finds that there were four (4) children born to the parties as the fruits of this marriage, all of whom are emancipated. The Court further finds that the parties have entered into a stipulation and agreement, which is now submitted to the court for its approval, and which is in these words and figures to-wit:

Comes now the petitioner, Wayne Decker in court in person and by counsel, James Daugherty. Comes now the respondent Virginia Decker, in court in person and by counsel, David Stevens.

Parties now enter into the following Property Settlement and agreement, to-wit:

1. Respondent, Wife, to have family residence at 8152 Sycamore Street, Highland, Lake County, Indiana, subject to a mortgage in favor of John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Company and a mortgage to the petitioner Huband, in the amount of \$1,300.00. SAid mortgage not be paid until respondent sells the family residence. Petitioner, Husband to execute a quit claim deed of all his right, title and interest to the respondent, Wife.

2. Petitioner, Husband, shall retain a 1977 Ford Van, as his sole and separate property; Respondent, Wife, shall retain a 1977 Buick automobile as her sole and separate property.

3. Petitioner, Husband to assume all obligations incurred during coverture prior to the date of September 2, 1977, and hold respondent, Wife, harmless from the same.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the stipulation and agreement as hereinabove set out is now approved by the Court and made a part of this order and decree, and the petitioner shall pay all the costs.

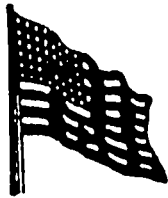
