I, MARTHA KOPPALA, of Lake County, Indiana, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and realizing the certainty of death and the uncertainty of life, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all wills and codicils which may have been by me heretofore made.

ARTICLE I. I direct that all my just debts, including funeral expenses and expenses of last illness be paid as soon after death as may be convenient, and that such debts and expenses be paid out of the principal of my estate generally.

ARTICLE II. I direct that my Executor pay out of the principal of my estate generally, all taxes and so-called inheritance taxes and other charges that may be assessed against my estate or the interest of any beneficiary, devisee or legatee hereunder.

ARTICLE III. I hereby nominate and appoint Lester A. Ottenheimer, Jr. as Executor of this my Last Will and Testament. It is my desire that said Executor serve without bond.

ARTICLE IV. I hereby acknowledge that I have a step-daughter, THELMA WANKO, who resides in Pennsylvania, but because of her treatment of me over the past many years, I am eliminating her from this Will and I direct that she take nothing from my estate.

ARTICLE V. I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of my property, real, mixed, or personal, including stocks, bonds or cash in banks of whatsoever kind and description and wheresoever situated of which I am seized at the time of my death, to my friend, JOHN HUGHES MC KENNA, who for many years has attended to my needs and welfare.

ARTICLE VI. It is my desire that I be buried at Elmwood Cemetary in Hammond, Indiana.
