Parcel I: Part of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 32, Township 36 North, Range 7 West of the Second Principal Meridian, described as commencing at the intersection of the North line of 7th Street with the West line of Lincoln Street in George & William Earle's Second Subdivision as shown in Plat Book 6, page 45, Lake County, Indiana, thence North along the West line of Lincoln Street 42 feet to the Southerly line of the right of way of the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railroad, thence Southwesterly along said Southerly line 60 feet to its intersection with the North line of 7th Street, thence East along the North line of 7th Street 43 feet to the place of beginning, City of Hobart, Lake County, Indiana.
