

It is, therefore, found that the culmative effect of the code violations present on the premises renders the premises unsafe, sub-standard, and a danger to the health and safety of the public as defined by I. C. (1981) 36-7-9-2.

It is further found that major reconstruction of the building(s) is necessary to bring the property up to the Property Maintenance Code of the City of Hammond and that respondent(s) made no serious efforts to make the property safe, although respondent(s) had notice and opportunity to do so since 11-8-84.

IT IS, THEREFORE, THE ACTION OF THE UNDESIGNED TO:

Affirm the order, but to repair the structure rather than to demolish, and make the owner responsible for the complete repairs of the structure as per City codes, and responsible to return on 12-20-84. Re: compliance.
