I, EDWARD GRISKO, a resident of the City of Hammond, County of Lake, State of Indiana, do hereby make, publish, and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills and codicils made by me.

FIRST:

It is my desire and I hereby direct my executor, hereinafter named, to pay all of my just debts, funeral expenses, and costs of administration of my estate.

SECOND:

I hereby give, will, and bequeath unto my good friend, Helen Gibbs of Hammond, Indiana, any and all real and personal property which I may own or to which I am entitled at the time of my death, with the exception of that property listed in the following paragraph of this Will. This bequest includes all of my real property in fee simple, and all of my personal property, including but not limited to, automobiles, furniture, pictures, appliances, cash, jewelry, and antiques. Should Helen Gibbs fail to survive me, then I direct that this property be given to Joseph Bogusz, Jr., of Hammond, Indiana.

THIRD:

I hereby give, will, and bequeath to my godson and friend Joseph Bogusz, Jr., of Hammond, Indiana, the contents, proceeds, and value of any account in my sole name at the First Bank of Whiting in Whiting, Indiana. This includes passbook accounts, checking accounts, certificates of deposit, money market funds, or any other account in my sole name First Bank of Whiting in Whiting, Indiana.

I also give, will, and bequeath to this same Joseph Bogusz, Jr., any and all shares of corporate stock which I may own and hold in my sole name at the time of my death.

Should Joseph Bogusz, Jr. fail to survive me, then I direct that the property described in this Third Article of my Will be given to Helen Gibbs.....

I nominate Helen Gibbs of Hammond, Indiana, to serve without surety on her bond, as Executrix of this Will. In the event of her death, or refusal or inability to act as Executrix of this Will, I hereby nominate Joseph Bogusz, Jr. of Hammond, Indiana to serve without bond as my Executor.

FIFTH:

I give all the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, of every kind wherever situated, which I may own at my death, including all bequests and devises to any person who may predecease me or which for any reason may lapse or fail, except as otherwise as in this Will specifically provided and excepting any property over which I may have a power of appointment, to Helen Gibbs of Hammond, Indiana. Should she fail to survive me, then I give the residue to Joseph Bogusz, Jr. of Hammond, Indiana.

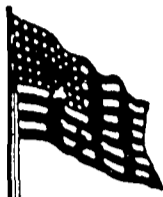
