5. That there is no Federal estate or Indiana inheritance tax owed on decedent's estate.

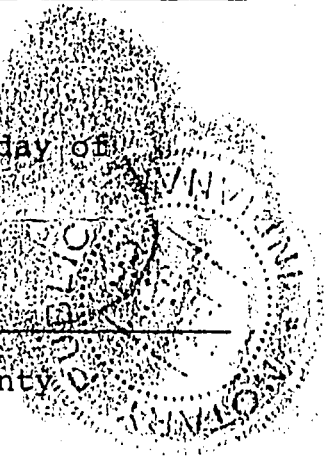
