That Frances Ostrowski, died testate, a resident of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, on the 29th day of February, 1984, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 28th day of March, 1984, and this Court appointed said Stanley Dostatni, Sr., executor, as executor of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and said executor was issued Letters of Testamentary on the 28th day of March, 1984, to him and since that date he has continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said account and petition are true, and that said executor has accounted for all the assets in said estate coming into his hands.

4. More than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; no claims were filed against said estate; neither said decedent nor her executor was an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all debts, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said estate have been paid.


3. That pursuant to the decedent's Last Will and Testament the following described real estate, to-wit:

Office of Lake County, Indiana.

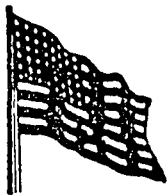
is hereby vested in Stanley Dostatni, Sr., pursuant to the provisions of the decedent's Last Will and Testament.
