LEGAL DESCRIPTION:

Part of the fractional Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 35 North, Range 10 West of the Second Principal Meridian, in the Town of Dyer, Lake County, Indiana described as follows: Beginning at a point that is found at the intersection of the centerline of the 99-foot right of way of the Joliet and Northern Indiana Railroad with the State Line of Indiana and Illinois; thence Easterly on said centerline 1354 feet; thence Northerly at right angles to said centerline 18 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing Northerly on said line that is at right angles to the centerline of said 99-foot right of way, 218.5 feet; thence Easterly at right angles and parallel to said centerline 436.5 feet to line that is believed to be original East line of the West Half of said Section 12; thence Southerly, on a line that makes an interior angle of 90 degrees 26 minutes measured West to South with the aforesaid 436.5 foot line, 218.5 feet to a line parallel to and 18 feet Northerly of the centerline of said 99 foot right of way; thence Westerly along said 18 foot parallel line, 438.2 feet to the point of beginning.
