ORDER APPROVING EXECUTOR'S FINAL ACCOUNT AND ORDER OF DISTRIBUTION OF PERSONALTY AND REAL

Fluxuel A This cause came to be heard on the 10th day of upon the Final Account, Petition to settle account and for authority to distribute assets filed by Raymond Joseph Carich as Executor of the Estate of George Carich, Deceased, which Account and Petition are in the following words and figurest, to-wit:

It appearing that objections were filed thereto and the Court being duly advised in the premises now finds that:

- Due Notice of the filing of said Account and Petition of the Hearing of the same was given by publication and that the same is now properly before the Court for final action thereon.
- 2.1 That George Carich, died testate, a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on the 8th day of December, 1984 and that his Last Will and Testament was admitted to Probate before this Court on the 19th day of April, 1985, and that this Court appointed said Raymond Joseph Carich, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of the decedent, and that said Executor was issued Letters Testamentary to him on the 19th day of April, 1985, and since that date has continued to serve in such capacity.
- That the matters and things stated in said Account and Petition of the Executor are true, and that said Executor has accounted for all assets in the Estate coming into his hands.
- That more than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published Notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said decedent; all claims filed against said Estate have been paid and discharged; neither said decedent nor his Executor was an employer of their in the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; that Estate taxes, Inheritance Taxes and gross And me Caxes, if any, assessed in said Estate have been paid.

That, pursuant to the Last Will and Testament of George Carich, dated August 31, 1967 and duly admitted and approved for Probate

in this Court, and that pursuant to the terms of Article VI thereof, Raymond Joseph Carich, the decedent's son, is the sole heir and is entitled to distribution of the real and personal property of the Estate of George Carich.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

- 1. Said Final Report and Accounting of said Executor is hereby and in all things approved, settled and confirmed.
- 2. That the following described real estate is by order of this Court transferred to the sole ownership of Raymond Joseph Carich in fee-simple, which real estate is described as follows:

Lots 18 and 19 in Block 8, Broadway Realty an Investment Company's Addition to Gary, Lake County, Indiana, commonly known as 4668 Delaware St., Gary, Indiana.

3. That all of the following described personalty and all of the interest and income therefrom is the property of Raymond Joseph Carich:

Gainer Bank, Checking Acct. #558-432-7 (Valued as 12-8-84, \$50.61)

Household goods and furnishings and proceeds from the sale thereof (\$1,156.50)

1977 Chevrolet, motor vehicle, 4-door sedan ID #IN69U7J130549 (\$1,200.00)

Gainer Bank, Savings Acct. #010-55-026162 (Valued as 12-8-84, \$513.57)

First National Bank, Nappanee, Indiana (CD #100 142; valued as 12-8-84 \$10,000.00)

First National Bank, Nappanee, Indiana (CD#010-0044188, valued as 12-8-84, \$5,000.00).

4. All of the above assets of personalty and realty, being all of the assets held in the Estate of George Carich, deceased, are hereby ordered to be transferred to Raymond Joseph Carich as the sole heir of the Estate, and Raymond Joseph Carich, is to report upon the Final Distribution of the assets in Supplemental Accounting and he will then he released and discharged from any further liability and responsibility as Executor of the Estate of George Carich, deceased. ALL OF WHICH IS ORDERED THIS 1986.
