**ORDER APPROVING CO-EXECUTORS'  
PETITION TO SETTLE AND ALLOW ACCOUNT, PETITION FOR  
APPROVAL OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS AND TO CLOSE ESTATE**

This cause came to be heard on the 28th day of February, 1986, upon the Final Petition to Settle and Allow Account, Petition for Approval of Distribution of Assets and to Close Estate, filed by George R. French and Richard A. French, Co-Executors of the Estate of Dagmar French, deceased, which Petition is in the words and figures following, to-wit: (H.I.)

And it appearing that no objections were filed thereto and the Court being fully advised in the premises now finds that:

1. Due notice of the filing of the Petition and of the hearing on the same were given to all persons interested in said Estate, and the same are now properly before the Court for final action thereon.

2. That Dagmar French died testate, a resident of Lake County, Indiana, on the 6th day of November, 1984, and her Last Will and Testament was duly admitted to probate before this Court on the 28th day of December, 1984, and this Court appointed George R. French and Richard A. French as Co-Executors of the Estate of Dagmar French, and said Co-Executors were issued Letters Testamentary on the 28th day of December, 1984, and since that date they have continued to serve in such capacity.

3. That the matters and things stated in said Petition are true, and that said Co-Executors have accounted for all the assets in said Estate coming into their hands.

4. That more than five (5) months have elapsed since the date of first published notice to legatees, devisees and creditors of said Decedent; all claims filed against said Estate have been paid and discharged; neither said Decedent nor her Co-Executors were an employer of labor within the meaning of that term as used in the Indiana Employment Security Act; all Estate taxes, inheritance taxes and gross income taxes, if any, assessed in said Estate have been paid.

5. That the Decedent owned a certain piece of real estate located at 7103 Northcote, Hammond, Indiana, more particularly described as follows:

36-392-49 Lots 48, 49, and 50, Block 16, Unit 4 of Woodmar, in the City of Hammond, as shown in Plat Book 17, page 22, in Lake County, Indiana,

and title to said described real estate should vest in said respective devisees, each as to an undivided one-third (1/3) interest, pursuant to the terms of said Will.

6. The following persons are the legatees and devisees under the Decedent's Last Will and Testament:

George R. French  
Richard A. French  
Alice Marie French Kurs

and that all assets and property of this Estate remaining after payment of Decedent's debts and expenses of administration have been distributed to the above named persons, as evidenced by their Receipts and Releases which are attached to and made a part of the Final Petition.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court as follows:

1. Said Final Petition of said Co-Executors is hereby in all things approved, settled and confirmed.

2. That the distribution of the balance of the property remaining in said Co-Executors' hands for distribution has been made as prescribed under the Last Will and Testament of said Decedent and is hereby in all things approved.

3. Said Co-Executors, having made distribution of all assets and property and having attached Receipts and Releases evidencing said distribution to the devisees and legatees set forth in Paragraph 6 above, said distribution is hereby approved and confirmed.

4. That pursuant to the Decedent's Last Will and Testament, the following described real estate, to-wit:

Lots 48, 49, and 50, Block 16, Unit 4 of Woodmar, in the City of Hammond, as shown in Plat Book 17, page 22, in Lake County, Indiana,

is hereby vested in:

George R. French  
Richard A. French  
Alice Marie French Kurs

each as to an undivided one-third (1/3) interest, pursuant to the provisions of the Decedent's Last Will and Testament.

5. Said Co-Executors are hereby released and discharged from any further liability or responsibility as said Co-Executors of the Estate of Dagmar French.

All of which is Ordered this 28th day of February, 1986.

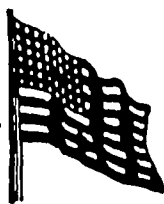
