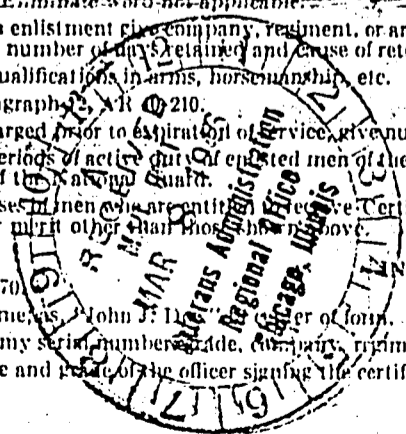

- 5 If discharged prior to expiration of service, give number, date, and source of order or full description of authority therefor.
- 6 Enter periods of active duty of enlisted men of the Regular Army Reserve and the Enlisted Reserve Corps and dates of induction into Regular Service in the cases of members of the Reserve.
- 7 In all cases of men who are entitled to Certificates of Service under AR 345-500, enter here appointments and ratings held and all other items of special proficiency or merit other than those mentioned above.
